Agency comments or recommendations, if any, as to statutory language, implementation, enforcement, and fiscal matters: Currently, all filer forms are printed as images within various sections of Title 390 WAC, making it cost, time, and labor-intensive to make any modifications to formatting or language. This has resulted in language on our forms that is hard to understand for filers and the public.								
Removing the forms from rule will allow us to update our formatting to keep pace with development of improved online filing platforms, quickly clarify language when it is unclear what is required to be disclosed, and adapt to the pace of technological progress (online advertising, electronic currency, etc.). Any substantive changes to the forms will be subject to approval and comment at open meetings of the Public Disclosure Commission, and notice of changes will be sent out to parties who have indicated their interest. This change retains the intent and impact of campaign finance law and regulation, while allowing the PDC to be more responsive to the needs of the community.
