

# 2007 Key Reporting Dates for Political Committees

Within two weeks of forming a committee	File a C-1pc (file amended C-1pc within ten days of change in committee makeup) <sup>1</sup>	
Jan 10	File monthly C-4 & C-3, if necessary	close of last report thru Dec 31
Feb 12	“ “	close of last report thru Jan 31
Mar 12	“ “	close of last report thru Feb 28
Apr 10	“ “	close of last report thru Mar 31
May 10	“ “	close of last report thru Apr 30
June 1	Begin filing C-3 reports weekly, each Monday, for deposits made during previous 7 days (Monday thru Sunday)	
June 11	File monthly C-4, if necessary	close of last report thru May 31
July 10	Final day to change from mini to full reporting without special circumstances <sup>2</sup>	
July 31	21 day pre-primary C-4 due <sup>3</sup>	June 1 thru July 24
Aug 13 - 20	Campaign books open for public inspection	
Aug 14	7 day pre-primary C-4 due	July 25 thru Aug 13
Aug 14 - 20	Special reports due if committee makes or receives contributions of \$1,000 or more in the aggregate. <sup>4</sup>	
<b>Aug 21</b>	<b>PRIMARY ELECTION DAY</b>	
Sept 10	Post-primary C-4 due	Aug 14 thru Aug 31
Sept 25	Final day to change from mini to full reporting without special circumstances <sup>2</sup>	
Oct 16	21 day pre-general C-4 due	Sep 1 thru Oct 9
Oct 16 – Nov 5	Special reports due if committee makes or receives contributions of \$1,000 or more in the aggregate. <sup>4</sup>	
	Further, unless the contributor is a <u>state committee</u> of a bona fide political party, no committee may now: 1) receive contributions over \$5,000 in the aggregate from one source or 2) make aggregate contributions totaling over \$5,000 to a candidate or other political committee.	
Oct 29 – Nov 5	Campaign books open for public inspection	
Oct 30	7 day pre-general C-4 due	Oct 10 thru Oct 29
<b>Nov 6</b>	<b>GENERAL ELECTION DAY</b>	
Dec 10	Post-general C-4 due (and C-3, if necessary)	Oct 30 thru Nov 30

<sup>1</sup> Committees forming within 3 weeks of the election must file C-1pc within 3 business days.

<sup>3</sup> Primary reports not required of committees only supporting or opposing general election ballot issues. These committees file monthly reports for June, July, August – these reports are due on the 10<sup>th</sup> of the following month.
