Reason(s) for Modification (as stated by filer)	<ul> <li>Mr. Witting is requesting a reporting modification that would exempt him from disclosing the business customers that paid \$12,000 or more during the previous 12 months to Print NW, LLC, a commercial printer where he served as Chief Financial Officer.</li> <li>Mr. Witting stated that Print NW, LLC had annual sales of \$20 million, 160 employees and approximately 500 accounts. He said that approximately 200 business customers would be reportable.</li> </ul>

	<ul> <li>Mr. Witting sold his interest in Print NW, LLC in March 2017 and has not been an owner or officer for over a year.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Mr. Witting stated that making the customer list public would cause an unfair competitive disadvantage to Print NW, LLC.</li> </ul>
Other Issues	Mr. Witting disclosed payment for purchase printing from the State of Washington to Print NW, LLC during the previous 12 months as well as other governmental customers that paid \$12,000 or more to Print NW, LLC during the previous 12 months.
