Reason(s) for Modification (as stated by filer)	 Mr. Lisbin is requesting a reporting modification that would exempt him from disclosing the business customers that paid \$12,000 or more during the previous 12 months to Point It!, Inc., a privately held online advertising agency located in the Seattle area. Mr. Lisbin stated that in 2018 Point It!, Inc. had 40 clients, 30 employees and an annual revenue between three and five million. Mr. Lisbin was a more than 10% owner of Point It!, Inc. but sold all ownership interest and stock in the business in August 2018. Mr. Lisbin stated that prior to August 2018, his role was limited, and he did not have direct contact with its customers. Mr. Lisbin stated that the share purchase agreement he signed in August 2018, included a Confidentiality Clause prohibiting him from disclosing the customers of Point It!, Inc.

Other Issues	Mr. Lisbin confirmed that Point It!, Inc. does no business with the City of Seattle and that there are no reportable governmental customers.
	If elected to the Seattle City Council, Mr. Lisbin agreed to recuse himself if a matter came before him involving a conflict of interest between Point It!, Inc. and the City of Seattle.
