Reason(s) for Modification (as stated by filer)	 Ms. Hodge is requesting a partial reporting modification that would exempt her from disclosing her residential address on her Personal Financial Affairs Statement (F-1 report) covering calendar year 2019, due to safety concerns. Ms. Hodge is also requesting a retroactive reporting modification that would exempt her from disclosing her residential address on each F-1 report filed as an elected official covering calendar years 2015, 2016, 2017 and 2018, due to safety concerns. In her application, Ms. Hodge stated that due to a threat she received from union representatives to come to her residence, she is concerned about her safety and that of her family. She stated that she is also concerned about future protests pertaining to union negotiations that may occur at her residence.
Other Issues	 Ms. Hodge has agreed to recuse herself if a matter came before her involving a conflict of interest between her personal financial information and her duties as an elected official. PDC staff have informed Ms. Hodge of the residential address alternatives set forth in <u>WAC 390-24-200</u>. Ms. Hodge's records would be exempt from public disclosure if the Commission finds in accordance with <u>RCW 42.17A.120</u> and <u>WAC 390-28-080</u> that disclosure of such information would present a personal risk to a reasonable person.
