<b>Reason(s) for Modification (as stated by filer)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Ms. Brown is requesting a reporting modification that would exempt her from disclosing the business and other governmental customers that paid \$12,000 or more during the previous 12 months to the University of Washington where her dependent daughter serves as an appointed Student Regent.</li> <li>• Ms. Brown stated that UW has over 25,000 employees, 3 campuses, several remote locations, revenue and expenses in the millions and extensive real estate holdings.</li> <li>• Ms. Brown stated that she has no access to information regarding the university other than public information and that she does not know if her daughter, as a student regent, has access to any additional information.</li> <li>• Ms. Brown stated that she has no involvement in the day-to-day operations of the UW and that no member of her family has any financial interest in the university.</li> </ul>
<b>Other Issues</b>	Ms. Brown stated that the PCHB/SHB are quasi-judicial boards that hear administrative appeals. The Board consists of 3 members and are subject to the Administrative Procedures Act and judicial code of conduct. If a member has ethical conflicts and cannot serve as an unbiased decision maker on a specific appeal, they must recuse themselves from hearing the appeal. In addition, the Boards rulemaking authority is limited to adopting procedural rules for their hearings.
<b>Staff Recommendations</b>	Staff recommends approval of the reporting modification.
