Reason(s) for Modification (as stated by filer)	 Mr. Dammeier is requesting renewal of a reporting modification that would exempt him from disclosing the business customers that paid \$12,000 or more during 2018 to Valley Press d.b.a. Print NW. Print NW is a commercial printing business in Washington. Mr. Dammeier stated that, in 2018, Print NW had annual sales of \$20.2 million, with 1,233 accounts, and 179 employees. He said that 203 business customers would be subject to disclosure.

	 Mr. Dammeier is a minority owner/partner of Print NW, he owns a 20.4% interest. He stated that he is not involved in the day-to-day operations and does not have direct access to customer lists. He said his role is strategic in nature and largely carried out through his participation in quarterly board meetings at which board members review performance and plan for the future of the company. Mr. Dammeier stated that disclosing the business customers will create a competitive disadvantage for Print NW, since the printing business is a highly competitive industry.
Other Issues	Mr. Dammeier disclosed payment for printing services from Pierce County Parks Department and from Tacoma-Pierce County Health Department to Print NW in 2018 as well as two other governmental customers that paid \$12,000 or more to Print NW in 2018. Mr. Dammeier stated by letter that the facts in his current request are the same as those that have been presented and approved in previous requests.
