History (brief narrative)	Energy Northwest is a joint operating agency, comprised of 28 member public utilities from across Washington. The Executive Board is made up of eleven members, 3 of which are appointed by the Governor. The agency is headquartered in Richland, Washington and provides electricity, at cost, to public utilities and municipalities. The agency owns and operates four electricity generating stations in Washington. The agency also provides operations and maintenance services for other power generation facilities in the state.
Reason(s) for Modification (as stated by filer)	 Mr. Daudon is requesting renewal of a reporting modification that would exempt him from disclosing the business customers who paid \$12,000 or more during 2014 to Cascadia Consulting Group Inc., for whom he is President /Principal and has a 45% ownership interest. Mr. Daudon stated that Cascadia Consulting is an environmental and
	sustainability consulting firm serving public and private clients with offices in Seattle, Washington and San Jose, California. The firm has 50 employees. • Mr. Daudon stated that he has access to the firm's client list and there are
	approximately 10 to 12 reportable business customers of the firm.
	 Mr. Daudon stated that some former business clients are listed on the firm's website. He stated that the website also lists the firm's public/governmental clients.
	 Mr. Daudon stated that disclosing the firm's business customers would cause a competitive hardship because the firm's competitors would become aware of the names of Cascadia's clients. He further stated that the client list is proprietary and that it would be disadvantageous to have all of their clients listed in one

	place and to have clients in the same sector knowing whom they serve. He said the firm has non-disclosure agreements with some business clients.
	 Mr. Daudon stated that the firm's reportable business customers are not in the energy business and do not do business with Energy Northwest, as far as he is aware.
	Mr. Daudon disclosed the firm's governmental customers. He stated that Cascadia Consulting did not receive payments from Energy Northwest during the reporting period.
Staff Recommendations	Approve renewal of the reporting modification with no change.
