Reason(s) for Modification (as stated by filer)	 Mr. Hein is requesting a reporting modification that would exempt him from disclosing the business customers that paid \$10,000 or more during the previous 12 months, when he was a candidate, as well as calendar year 2013, to Shoemaker Manufacturing. Mr. Hein serves as president with an ownership interest of 1.5%.
	Mr. Hein stated that Shoemaker Manufacturing is a heating, ventilation and air conditioning manufacturing company located in Cle Elum which performs precision manufacturing services for the HVAC industry.
	Mr. Hein stated that Shoemaker Manufacturing has 85 employees at their Cle Elum facility as well as 37 contracted salesmen throughout the United States.
	Mr. Hein stated that Shoemaker Manufacturing has annual sales of approximately \$16 million and has 200 customers, all of which meet the reporting threshold. He also stated that there are no reportable governmental customers.
	Mr. Hein stated that Shoemaker Manufacturing is a privately held company and that a list of its customers is not publically available.
	Mr. Hein stated that the HVAC manufacturing industry is highly competitive and publishing the reportable business customers would put them at a serious competitive disadvantage.
	 Mr. Hein stated that none of the reportable business customers are located in the Cle Elum – Roslyn school district and that neither those customers or Shoemaker Manufacturing do business with the Cle Elum – Roslyn School District.
	Mr. Hein stated that it would be a hardship, given the time required, to compile a

	list of the reportable business customers of Shoemaker Manufacturing.
Other Issues	Mr. Hein disclosed that if any matter came before him involving Shoemaker Manufacturing, or its customers, that he would recuse himself.
