SUBJECT: James Fossos, 2011 Candidate for Fire Commissioner - Stipulation and

Recommendation About Remaining Allegations, Case No. 12-159

Allegations for which Respondent and Staff Are Stipulating to Violations

James Fossos was a candidate for Fire Commissioner for South King Fire and Rescue in 2011. This case involves violations of the state campaign finance disclosure laws during the 2011 election cycle as follows:

- A. Failing to timely report expenditures and in-kind contributions for political advertising, including newspaper advertising, printing and mailing, and signs on Campaign Summary Receipts and Expenditures reports (C-4 reports); and
- B. Failing to timely disclose monetary contributions on Cash Receipts Monetary Contributions reports (C-3 reports).

Staff will be providing you a Stipulation as to Facts, Violations and Penalty for your consideration that staff and the Respondent believe accurately describes the nature of the violations, the relevant facts, and an appropriate penalty. We will also provide a document showing comparable cases. We will be requesting the Commission to accept the Stipulation.

Remaining Allegations and Staff Recommendations

This case also involves two additional allegations that PDC staff is recommending be dismissed as follows:

 Allegation that Mr. Fossos accepted anonymous contributions in excess of the \$300 statutory limit and/or failed to properly report the identity of contributors

Under PDC reporting requirements, Mr. Fossos was limited to receiving \$300 in anonymous or unidentified contributions during his 2011 campaign. The complaint alleged that Mr. Fossos incorrectly reported contributions received by his campaign as anonymous contributions, when in fact the contributions were attributable to sources that

were known to him. The Fossos campaign filed the following C-3 reports disclosing anonymous contributions:

- On September 12, 2011, a C-3 report disclosed \$366 in anonymous contributions received on September 6, 2011.
- On October 10, 2011, a C-3 report disclosed an additional \$226 in anonymous contributions received on September 27, 2011, making an aggregate total of \$592.

After being made aware of the complaint and the limit on anonymous contributions, Mr. Fossos reviewed the contributions received by his campaign and determined that his campaign had incorrectly reported \$300 in anonymous contributions on the September 12, 2011 C-3 report when he should have disclosed six \$50 contributions from six individual contributors.

On March 31, 2012, Mr. Fossos filed an amended C-3 report disclosing the names and addresses of the six contributors. Mr. Fossos stated that when he took the PDC compliance training class, he misunderstood the instructions and thought his campaign could accept up to \$50 anonymously, as long as he did not see who made the contribution. After Mr. Fossos filed the amended C-3 report on March 31, 2012, the campaign's anonymous contributions totaled \$292, under the \$300 limit for anonymous contributions.

Staff Recommendation

Mr. Fossos did not accept over-limit anonymous contributions. Although he initially misreported \$300 as being from anonymous sources, his campaign in fact was aware of the identity of the contributors. His failure to properly report the names and addresses of six \$50 contributions to the PDC was due to a misunderstanding of the reporting requirements, and the identity of the contributors has been disclosed through amended reports. For these reasons, the allegation that James Fossos violated RCW 42.17.060 by accepting anonymous contributions above the \$300 statutory limit should be dismissed.

• Allegation that Mr. Fossos failed to make his campaign books of account available for public inspection

Candidates appearing only on the 2011 general election ballot were required to make their books of account available for public inspection for two hours beginning eight days before the general election. Mr. Fossos contacted PDC staff by telephone and e-mail during the open records inspection period with questions and concerns about his safety and the safety of his spouse. He said he was not comfortable allowing the complainant to inspect the campaign records at his personal residence, which was the location Mr. Fossos had initially listed on his C-1 report for inspecting records.

On November 1, 2011, Mr. Fossos transmitted an e-mail to PDC staff as an attachment to his C-1 report stating "... due to security concerns I have changed my meeting place for candidate financial view of my books... to the Des Moines Library." Mr. Fossos stated

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that he had initially agreed to meet with the complainant to allow him to review his campaign books of account, but based on past interactions with the complainant at fire district meetings, he had concerns about his safety and the safety of his spouse.

Mr. Fossos stated that the complainant made an issue out of bringing his gun to the records inspection meeting. He said he asked the complainant not to bring his gun to the library for the inspection of his campaign records. Mr. Fossos stated that the complainant would not agree to his request, and when Mr. Fossos arrived at the library for the records inspection, the complainant and his assistant began to videotape their meeting. Mr. Fossos said he asked the complainant to stop videotaping, but he refused, resulting in Mr. Fossos informing the complainant that the inspection could not take place.

Staff Recommendation

Mr. Fossos made a good-faith effort to accommodate the complainant's request to inspect his campaign books of account during the 2011 general election. Under the circumstances, Mr. Fossos substantially complied with the inspection opportunity requirements, and the allegations that he violated RCW 42.17.080 should be dismissed.

Notice of Administrative Charges

I. Jurisdiction

 The Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) has jurisdiction over this proceeding pursuant to Chapter 42.17 RCW and Chapter 42.17A RCW, the state's campaign disclosure and contribution laws; Chapter 34.05 RCW, the Administrative Procedure Act; and Title 390 WAC. These charges incorporate the Report of Investigation and all related exhibits by reference.

II. Allegations

- 2. PDC staff alleges that James Fossos, a candidate for Fire Commissioner for South King Fire and Rescue in 2011, and the 2011 James Fossos campaign, violated RCW 42.17.080 and 42.17.090 by:
 - A. Failing to timely disclose expenditures and in-kind contributions for political advertising, including newspaper advertising, printing and mailing, and signs on Campaign Summary Receipts and Expenditures reports (C-4 reports); and
 - B. Failing to timely disclose monetary contributions on Cash Receipts Monetary Contributions reports (C-3 reports).

III. Facts

- 3. On June 27, 2011, James Fossos filed a Candidate Registration (C-1 report) declaring his candidacy for re-election to Fire Commissioner for South King Fire and Rescue, and selecting the Full Reporting option. Mary Fossos, the candidate's spouse, was listed as the campaign treasurer.
- 4. Mr. Fossos was first elected as a Fire Commissioner in 1993 to a six-year term, and was subsequently re-elected in 1999 and 2005. He was unopposed for his two prior re-election campaigns, having selected the Mini Reporting option on his C-1 report in 1999 and 2005.
- 5. Prior to the November 8, 2011 general election, Mr. Fossos timely filed four C-4 reports. They included the August C-4 report, the 21-day pre-general election C-4 report, the 7-day pre-general election C-4 report, and a C-4 report stating that it included activity for the month of November (the post-general election reporting period) even though it was filed on November 7, 2011.

James Fossos failed to timely disclose campaign expenditures and in-kind contributions for political advertising

- 6. During the period March 31 through April 3, 2012, Mr. Fossos amended or filed for the first time three C-4 reports, disclosing \$15,632 in previously un-reported campaign expenditures and in-kind contributions, as detailed below:
- 7. Amended 21-day pre-general election C-4 report: On April 3, 2012, Mr. Fossos filed an amended 21-day pre-general election C-4 report disclosing the following previously un-reported 2011 campaign activities totaling \$6,227: (1) A \$4,656 campaign expenditure to EASL, Inc. on October 12, 2011 for postage; and (2) A \$1,571 in-kind contribution from Mr. Fossos for two expenditures he made to the Federal Way Mirror on September 20, 2011 for web advertisements. The \$6,227 in previously un-reported campaign activities were disclosed 167 days late and 147 days after the November 8, 2011 general election.
- 8. <u>Amended 7-day pre-general election C-4 report:</u> On April 3, 2012, Mr. Fossos filed an amended 7-day pre-general election C-4 report disclosing the following previously unreported 2011 campaign activities totaling \$8,935: (1) A \$5,734 campaign expenditure to EASL, Inc. on October 18, 2011, for "final invoice for mail piece print, design, et al...;"

- and (2) A \$3,201 in-kind contribution from Mr. Fossos for an expenditure he made to The Sign Shop on October 31, 2011 for campaign yard signs. The \$5,734 in previously unreported campaign expenditures were disclosed 153 days late and 133 days after the November 8, 2011 general election. The \$3,201 in-kind contribution from Mr. Fossos for yard signs was disclosed six days late as an expenditure on a C-4 report filed on November 7, 2011, one day before the November 8, 2011 general election.
- 9. Filed June 2011 C-4 report: On March 31, 2012, Mr. Fossos filed a C-4 report for June 2011, covering the period June 22 through June 30, 2011, disclosing a \$470 in-kind contribution/loan from Mr. Fossos on June 24, 2011 for a political advertisement described as a "festival ad." The political advertisement was required to have been disclosed by Mr. Fossos as an in-kind contribution on the June 2011 C-4 report that was due on July 11, 2011. This \$470 previously unreported in-kind contribution from Mr. Fossos was disclosed 264 days late and 112 days after the November 8, 2011 general election.
- 10. Of the total expenditures and in-kind contributions made for the benefit of Mr. Fossos:(1) \$3,201 was disclosed six days late but prior to the November 8, 2011 general election being held; and (2) \$12,431 was disclosed 133 to 264 days late, and more than four months after the general election.

James Fossos failed to timely disclose monetary contributions on C-3 reports

- 11. On March 31, 2012, Mr. Fossos filed three amended C-3 reports, disclosing \$1,510 in previously un-reported monetary contributions, including the following:
- 12. On October 28, 2011, an \$800 monetary contribution was received by Mr. Fossos from IAFF Fire PAC, located in Washington D.C. This \$800 contribution was disclosed 144 days late on March 31, 2012. The contribution was required to be disclosed on a C-3 report filed by November 7, 2011, since it was deposited on October 31, 2011.
- 13. On August 8, 2011, a \$300 monetary contribution was received from Don Kennedy. This \$300 contribution was disclosed 221 days late on March 31, 2012. The contribution was required to be disclosed on a C-3 report due to be filed on August 22, 2011, since it was deposited on August 15, 2011.

- 14. On September 6, 2011, six \$50 monetary contributions totaling \$300 were received from six individuals that should have been deposited by September 12, 2011 and disclosed on a C-3 report on September 19, 2011. The six contributions were previously reported as anonymous contributions. The contributors were identified and disclosed 193 days late.
- 15. On September 27, 2011, a \$50 monetary contribution was received from an individual.

 That contribution should have been deposited by October 3, 2011 and disclosed on a C-3 report on October 10, 2011. The \$50 contribution was disclosed 172 days late.
- 16. On October 4, 2011, a \$40 contribution was received from Louis Batayola. The contribution should have been reported on October 10, 2011, but was not reported until March 31, 2012, 173 days late.
- 17. On September 12, 2011, Mr. Fossos contributed \$20 in personal funds. This contribution should have been reported on September 19, 2011, but was not reported until March 31, 2012, 194 days late.
- 18. The corrected, total monetary contributions received by Mr. Fossos during the 2011 election was \$14,552. Of that total, \$13,042 was timely disclosed by Mr. Fossos before the election, and \$1,510 was disclosed late after the election.

IV. Law

RCW 42.17.080 and .090 ¹ require candidates under the full reporting option to file timely, accurate reports of contribution and expenditure activities, including in-kind contributions. C-4 reports are required to be filed 21 and 7 days before each election, and a post-election report, when the candidates name appears on the ballot, and in the months following the election if the campaign has raised or spent \$200 since the last report. In addition, C-3 reports are due every Monday disclosing contributions received and deposited during the previous seven days.

I. Background

- 1.1 On June 27, 2011, James Fossos filed a Candidate Registration (C-1 report) declaring his candidacy for re-election to Fire Commissioner for South King Fire and Rescue, and selecting the full reporting option. Mary Fossos, the candidate's spouse, was listed as the campaign treasurer.
- 1.2 Mr. Fossos was first elected as a Fire Commissioner in 1993 to a six-year term, and was subsequently re-elected in 1999 and 2005. He was unopposed for his two prior re-election campaigns, having selected the mini reporting option on his C-1 report in 1999 and 2005.
- 1.3 For his 2011 re-election campaign, Mr. Fossos' opponent was Jerry Galland, the complainant in this matter. Because there were only two candidates, the names of both Mr. Fossos and Mr. Galland only appeared on the November 8, 2011 General election ballot. Mr. Fossos defeated Mr. Galland, and was re-elected Fire Commissioner.
- 1.4 Mr. Galland filed three complaints against Mr. Fossos concerning the 2011 election. The three complaints, filed on November 8, December 14, and December 28, 2011, were combined into one investigation, PDC Case No. 12-159. See Exhibit #1.

II. Allegations

- 2.1 Mr. Galland's complaints alleged that Mr. Fossos:
 - A. Failed to timely report expenditures and in-kind contributions for political advertising, including newspaper advertising, printing and mailing, and signs;
 - B. Failed to timely file a post-general election Campaign Summary Receipts and Expenditures report (C-4 report);
 - C. Failed to timely disclose contributions on Cash Receipts Monetary Contributions reports (C-3 reports);

- D. Accepted more than \$300 in anonymous contributions during his 2011 campaign, which, if true, would exceed the statutory limit for anonymous contributions. Mr. Galland further alleged that some of the anonymous contributions were attributable to known sources such that Mr. Fossos failed to properly report the names and addresses of some contributors; and
- E. Failed to make his campaign books available for public inspection during the eight days prior to the 2011 general election.

III. Findings

- 3.1 Mr. Fossos' campaign began in late June 2011. Under the Full Reporting option, as a candidate that only appeared on the November 8, 2011, general election ballot, Mr. Fossos was required to file C-3 reports and C-4 reports as follows:
 - Weekly C-3 reports were required to be filed every Monday beginning four months
 prior to the election, disclosing contributions received and deposited for the previous
 five business days;
 - Monthly C-4 reports were required by the 10th of every month or reporting period, that Mr. Fossos received \$200 in contributions or made \$200 in expenditures since the last C-4 report was filed;
 - A 21-day pre-general election C-4 report was required on October 18, 2011, covering the period September 1 through October 17, 2011;
 - A 7-day pre-general election C-4 report was required on November 1, 2011, covering the period October 18 through October 31, 2011;
 - A post-general election C-4 report was required no later than December 12, 2011, covering all of calendar month November 2011.
- 3.2 After filing several amended C-4 reports for the 2011 election cycle, the final C-4 report filed by Mr. Fossos disclosed that his campaign received a total of \$19,610 in monetary and in-kind contributions, and made \$16,217 in monetary and in-kind expenditures, with \$4,700 in outstanding liabilities.
- 3.3 On March 6, 2012, Mr. Fossos submitted a response to the allegations in the complaint. See Exhibit #2.

Allegation A: Mr. Fossos failed to timely disclose campaign expenditures and in-kind contributions for political advertising.

3.4 Prior to the November 8, 2011 general election, Mr. Fossos timely filed four C-4 reports. They included the August C-4 report, the 21-day pre-general election C-4 report, the 7-day pre-general election C-4 report, and a C-4 report stating that it included activity for the month of November (the post-general election reporting period) even though it was filed on November 7, 2011. When the November C-4 report was amended on April 3, 2012, it removed the \$3,201 in expenditures that were initially reported (the expenditures

- were included on an amended 7-day pre-general election C-4 report) and showed that no contribution or expenditure activity occurred during the month of November. Thus, the original post-general election C-4 report that was filed on November 7, 2011 was not late and did not exclude any November 2011 contribution or expenditure activity.
- 3.5 During the period March 31 through April 3, 2012, Mr. Fossos amended the four C-4 reports filed before the November 8, 2011 election. **See Exhibit #3.** Mr. Fossos also filed three "zero activity C-4 reports" for the periods of July 2011, December 2011, and January through March 2012. Those three reports did not disclose any additional contributions received or expenditures.
- 3.6 The amended 21-day and 7-day pre-general election C-4 reports, and the June 2011 C-4 report filed by Mr. Fossos, disclosed \$15,632 in previously un-reported campaign expenditures and in-kind contributions, as detailed below:
 - Amended 21-day pre-general election C-4 report: On April 3, 2012, Mr. Fossos filed an amended 21-day pre-general election C-4 report disclosing the following previously un-reported 2011 campaign activities totaling \$6,227: (1) A \$4,656 campaign expenditure to EASL, Inc. on October 12, 2011 for postage; and (2) A \$1,571 in-kind contribution from Mr. Fossos for two expenditures he made to the Federal Way Mirror on September 20, 2011 for web advertisements. The \$6,227 in previously unreported campaign activities were disclosed 167 days late and 147 days after the November 8, 2011 general election.
 - Amended 7-day pre-general election C-4 report: On April 3, 2012, Mr. Fossos filed an amended 7-day pre-general election C-4 report disclosing the following previously un-reported 2011 campaign activities totaling \$8,935: (1) A \$5,734 campaign expenditure to EASL, Inc. on October 18, 2011, for "final invoice for mail piece print, design, et al...;" and (2) A \$3,201 in-kind contribution from Mr. Fossos for an expenditure he made to The Sign Shop on October 31, 2011 for campaign yard signs. The \$5,734 in previously un-reported campaign expenditures were disclosed 153 days late and 133 days after the November 8, 2011 general election.
 - Late filed June 2011 C-4 report: On March 31, 2012, Mr. Fossos filed a C-4 report for June 2011, covering the period June 22 through June 30, 2011, disclosing a \$470 in-kind contribution/loan from Mr. Fossos on June 24, 2011 for a political advertisement described as a "festival ad." The political advertisement was required to have been disclosed by Mr. Fossos as an in-kind contribution on the June 2011 C-4 report on July 11, 2011. This \$470 previously unreported in-kind contribution from Mr. Fossos was disclosed 264 days late and 112 days after the November 8, 2011 general election.

Allegation B: Mr. Fossos failed to timely file a Post-general election C-4 report.

3.7 The \$3,201 in-kind contribution from Mr. Fossos for yard signs was disclosed six days late as an expenditure on the original post-general election C-4 report filed November 7, 2011, one day before the November 8, 2011 general election. The in-kind contributions should have been reported on November 1, 2011 on the 7-day pre-general election C-4 report.

- 3.8 As noted earlier, on April 3, 2012, Mr. Fossos filed an amended post-general election C-4 report disclosing that there was no contribution or expenditure activity during the post-general election C-4 reporting period of November 1 through November 30, 2011. This amended C-4 report replaced the post-general election C-4 report filed on November 7, 2011.
- 3.9 Of the total expenditures and in-kind contributions made for the benefit of Mr. Fossos, \$3,201 was disclosed six days late but prior to the November 8, 2011 general election, and \$12,431 was disclosed 133 to 264 days late, and more than four months after the election.

Allegation C: Mr. Fossos failed to timely disclose monetary contributions on C-3 reports

- 3.10 Prior to the November 8, 2011 general election, Mr. Fossos filed two C-3 reports disclosing that his campaign had received \$13,042 in monetary contributions. PDC staff reviewed the deposit dates listed on the C-3 reports and the Schedule A to C-4 reports, and found that Mr. Fossos timely filed the C-3 reports. One of the C-3 reports included a \$12,000 monetary contribution received on October 5, 2011 from IAFF Local 2024 that was timely deposited on October 6, 2011, and timely disclosed on October 10, 2011.
- 3.11 On March 31, 2012, Mr. Fossos filed three amended C-3 reports, disclosing \$1,510 in previously un-reported monetary contributions. See Exhibit #4. The amended C-3 reports included the following:
 - On October 28, 2011, Mr. Fossos received an \$800 monetary contribution from IAFF Fire PAC, located in Washington D.C. This \$800 contribution was disclosed 144 days late on March 31, 2012. The contribution was required to be disclosed on a C-3 report filed by November 7, 2011, since it was deposited on October 31, 2011.
 - On August 8, 2011, Mr. Fossos received a \$300 monetary contribution from Don Kennedy. This \$300 contribution was disclosed 221 days late on March 31, 2012. The contribution was required to be disclosed on a C-3 report due to be filed on August 22, 2011, since it was deposited on August 15, 2011.
 - On September 6, 2011, Mr. Fossos received six \$50 monetary contributions totaling \$300 from six individuals that should have been deposited by September 12, 2011 and disclosed on a C-3 report on September 19, 2011. The six contributions were previously reported as anonymous contributions. The contributors were identified and disclosed 193 days late.
 - On September 27, 2011, Mr. Fossos received a \$50 monetary contribution from an individual. That contribution should have been deposited by October 3, 2011 and disclosed on a C-3 report on October 10, 2011. The \$50 contribution was disclosed 172 days late.
 - On October 4, 2011, Mr. Fossos received a \$40 contribution from Louis Batayola. The contribution should have been reported on October 10, 2011, but was not reported until March 31, 2012, 173 days late.

- On September 12, 2011, Mr. Fossos contributed \$20 in personal funds. This contribution should have been reported on September 19, 2011, but was not reported until March 31, 2012, 194 days late.
- 3.12 The corrected, total monetary contributions Mr. Fossos received during the 2011 election was \$14,552. Of that total, Mr. Fossos timely disclosed 92% before the election, and 8% was disclosed late after the election.

Allegation D: Mr. Fossos accepted anonymous contributions in excess of \$300 statutory limit and/or failed to properly report identity of contributors

- 3.13 Under the PDC reporting requirements, Mr. Fossos was limited to receiving \$300 in anonymous or unidentified contributions. The complaint alleged that Mr. Fossos incorrectly reported contributions received by his campaign as anonymous contributions, when in fact the contributions were attributable to sources that were known to him.
- 3.14 The Fossos campaign filed the following C-3 reports during the 2011 election cycle disclosing anonymous contributions:
 - On September 12, 2011, Mr. Fossos timely filed a C-3 report disclosing that his campaign had received \$366 in anonymous contributions on September 6, 2011.
 - On October 10, 2011, Mr. Fossos filed a C-3 report disclosing that his campaign had received an additional \$226 in anonymous contributions on September 27, 2011, and an aggregate total of \$592 in anonymous contributions.
- 3.15 After being made aware of the complaint and the limit on anonymous contributions, Mr. Fossos reviewed the contributions received by his campaign and determined that his campaign had incorrectly reported \$300 in anonymous contributions on the September 12, 2011 C-3 report when he should have disclosed six \$50 contributions from six individual contributors.
- 3.16 On March 31, 2012, Mr. Fossos filed an amended C-3 report disclosing the names and addresses of the six contributors and listing them in Section 2 of the C-3 report. The amended C-3 report included 14 contributions for which the name and address were provided, disclosing contributions received from September 6 through October 28, 2011. Mr. Fossos stated that when he took the PDC compliance training class, he misunderstood the instructions and thought he could accept up to \$50 anonymously, as long as he did not see who made the contribution.
- 3.17 After Mr. Fossos filed the amended C-3 report on March 31, 2012, the campaign's anonymous contributions totaled \$292, under the \$300 limit for anonymous contributions.

Allegation E: Mr. Fossos failed to make campaign books of account available for public inspection

3.18 Candidates appearing only on the 2011 general election ballot were required to make their books of account available for public inspection for two hours beginning eight days

- prior to the general election. For the 2011 general election, the records inspection period was from October 31 through November 7, 2011.
- 3.19 Mr. Fossos contacted PDC staff by telephone and e-mail during the open records inspection period with questions and concerns about his safety and the safety of his spouse. He said he was not comfortable allowing Mr. Galland to inspect the campaign records at his personal residence, which was the location Mr. Fossos had initially listed on his C-1 report for inspecting records.
- 3.20 On November 1, 2011, Mr. Fossos transmitted an e-mail to PDC staff as an attachment to his C-1 report stating "... due to security concerns I have changed my meeting place for candidate financial view of my books... to the Des Moines Library." See Exhibit #5.
- 3.21 Mr. Fossos stated in his response letter to the complaint that he had initially agreed to meet with Mr. Galland to allow him to review his campaign books of account. However, he noted that based on past interactions with Mr. Galland at fire district meetings, Mr. Fossos had concerns about his safety and the safety of his spouse.
- 3.22 Mr. Fossos stated that Mr. Galland made an issue out of bringing his gun to the records inspection. Mr. Fossos said he asked Mr. Galland not to bring his gun to the library for the inspection of his campaign records. Mr. Fossos stated that Mr. Galland would not agree to his request. He went on to state the following about his dispute with Mr. Galland over inspecting his campaign records:
 - "...and when I got there he and his assistant began to videotape our meeting. I asked him to turn off the camera before I would meet with him and show him my books and he refused...I informed him as long as he would not turn the camera off I would not meet with them. After which he became confrontational and belligerent..."

IV. Scope

As part of its investigation, PDC staff reviewed:

- 4.1 The complaints filed against James Fossos.
- 4.2 The C-3 and C-4 reports filed by Mr. Fossos' 2011 campaign.
- 4.3 Mr. Fossos' response to the complaints.
- 4.4 Records of communications from Mr. Fossos regarding open inspection requirements and issues.

V. Law

5.1 **RCW 42.17.080 and .090** require candidates to file timely, accurate reports of contributions and expenditures, including in-kind contributions. Under the full reporting option, C-3 and C-4 reports are required to be filed monthly when contributions or expenditures exceed \$200 since the last report. During the election cycle, C-3 reports are required to be filed weekly and C-4 reports are required 21 and 7 days before each election, and in the month following the election, regardless of the level of activity.

- 5.2 **RCW 42.17.060(4)** states that anonymous contributions, in excess of one percent of the total accumulated contributions received in the current calendar year, or three hundred dollars, whichever is more, may not be used, or expended, but shall be returned to the donor if his or her identity can be ascertained. If the donor cannot be ascertained, the contribution shall escheat to the state and shall be paid to the state treasurer for deposit in the state general fund.
- 5.3 RCW 42.17.080(4) states that during the eight days immediately preceding the date of the election the books of account shall be kept current within one business day. As specified in the committee's statement of organization filed under RCW 42.17A.205, the books of account must be open for public inspection by appointment at the designated place for inspections between 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. on any day from the eighth day immediately before the election through the day immediately before the election, other than Saturday, Sunday, or a legal holiday. It is a violation of this chapter for a candidate or political committee to refuse to allow and keep an appointment for an inspection to be conducted during these authorized times and days. The appointment must be allowed at an authorized time and day for such inspections that is within twenty-four hours of the time and day that is requested for the inspection.



A. RCW 42.17.060 (4) Candidate Fossos filed with the PDC on two separate occasions form C3 dated 9/12/11 and C3 dated 10/10/11 contributions received from 'Anonymous' in the amounts of \$366.00 and \$226.00 respectively. The campaign for James A Fossos has contributions below \$30,000 resulting in a maximum limit of \$300 for the calendar year 2011. There is no record that the campaign returned the excess to the donor(s) nor was the money escheated to the state as required by this law. Mr. Fossos makes no declaration of Fund-raising activities as defined in RCW 42.17.067.

B. RCW 42.17.080(2c) Expenditures for advertising with the Federal Way Mirror (Sound Publishing) for print advertising and internet advertising were under reported. Actual dates expenditures were made have not been reported (RCW 42.17.090 (1f)) and receipts were



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not provided when records inspection as required by RCW 42.17.080(4) was requested.

This is compounded with a violation of RCW 42.17.080(4) by not accurately reflecting expenditures within five business days of expenditure.

C. RCW 42.17.080(3) Candidate used funds deposited into account under the name Anonymous to hide identity of known contributors who may have used PayPal for these donations and that some of these contributions are alleged to have exceeded the limit of twenty-five dollars in the aggregate from any one person while the name is not listed on any C3 forms filed.


D. RCW 42.17.080(2c) Candidate made expenditures for publishing mailers sent to thousands of voters in the district by United States Postal Service. Actual dates expenditures were made have not been reported (RCW 42.17.090 (1f)) nor were receipts for this expenditure provided for review when records inspection as required by RCW 42.17.080(4) was requested nor has this expenditure been reported to the PDC on any report filed by candidate.

E. RCW 42.17.080(4) by not accurately reflecting expenditures within five business days of expenditure. Signs purchased from The Sign Shop in Tumwater, Washington were purchased and paid for earlier in the campaign year but candidate waited until November 7, 2011 to record or report the expenditure nor have actual dates expenditures were made been reported (RCW 42.17.090 (1f)).

F. RCW 42.17.090 (1f) On November 7, 2011, candidate filed a C3 report with the PDC on which a \$10,360.24 'expenditure' is inappropriately recorded. Line 10 reads "Previous total cash and in kind expenditures (from line 17, last C-4)" and candidate entered \$13,008.24. The last C4 filed by candidate was on November 1, 2011 and showed a "Total Cash and in kind expenditures during campaign" of \$2618.00.

This is clearly in violation of contents of report providing the name and address of each person to whom an expenditure was made in the aggregate amount of more than fifty dollars during the period covered by this report, and the amount, date, and purpose of each such expenditure.

Nowhere in the report or associated schedules is the missing \$10,360.24 identified.

As specified in the committee's statement of organization filed under RCW 42.17.040, the books of account must be open for public inspection by appointment at the designated place for inspections between 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. on any day from the eighth day immediately before the election through the day immediately before the election, other than Saturday, Sunday, or a legal holiday. It is a violation of this chapter for a candidate or political committee to refuse to allow and keep an appointment for an inspection to be conducted during these authorized times and days. The appointment must be allowed at an authorized time and day for such



inspections that is within twenty-four hours of the time and day that is requested for the inspection.

James A Fossos was the incumbent Fire Commissioner and was an elected official running for re-election in the November 8, 2011 general election.

On October 27, 2011 Jennifer Hansen of the PDC sent a reminder to all 2011 candidates and their treasures that they were required to have your campaign records available during the public inspection period.

On October 31, 2011, using the email address provided on the PDC filed documents for campaign contact I emailed James A Fossos requesting an appointment to inspect his accounts at the place where the books were kept. At the time of the request, the address of inspection was the home address of the candidate.

Through a series of email communications with candidate James A Fossos and PDC Filer Assistance Specialist Jennifer Hansen, an appointment was finally made for this purpose on November 2, 2011 for 3:15pm at the Des Moines branch of the King County Library (KCLS) System.

Within the emails that were sent to me from James A Fossos arranging the time and place for this inspection were shocking, unsolicited and unwarranted references to weapons, specifically guns, and the indication that Fire Commissioner James A Fossos somehow deemed is necessary to come to this meeting armed. Of special note was his suggestion that we "and leave guns outsidew".

This reference alarmed me as the inspection of the candidate records are required by RCW 42.17.080(4) and all communication prior to Fire Commissioner James A Fossos making the request were simple requests for compliance with this statute. One would conclude that the comments made by Commissioner James A Fossos were of a nature that seemed intent on intimidation and threat.

Feeling uncomfortable with the unexpected tone of the emails from Fire Commissioner James A Fossos, and with the knowledge that the KCLS is a public place and that Fire Commissioner James A Fossos is an elected official, I made arrangements for the meeting to be recorded by a third person with a video camera, an item of the third persons personal property.

At approximately 3:10 on November 2nd I arrived at the Des Moines branch of the KCLS, and saw Fire Commissioner James A Fossos outside on the sidewalk. He was holding a notebook in one hand and held a cell phone to his ear with the other.

Also in the vicinity was the third party I had requested and he was recording me with his video camera.

I approached Fire Commissioner James A Fossos and confirmed that we had a meeting scheduled and he said to go inside, he would be there in five minutes.

I waited inside the library until 3:35pm and Fire Commissioner James A Fossos at no time entered the building.

At 3:35pm, I walked outside to find Fire Commissioner James A Fossos still on the sidewalk with the notebook in one hand and still speaking into the cell phone. I asked if he intended to keep the appointment, and after his conversed into his cell phone, Fire Commissioner James A Fossos abruptly told me that he would not meet with me. A few moments later he left the library in a red Ford Focus and, to this date, I have not had an opportunity to inspect the campaign records.

Further, as of the date of this complaint, Fire Commissioner James A Fossos has failed in complying with the laws of Washington State regarding campaign finance and the filing of records that would make public the contributions and expenses of his campaign.

Fire Commissioner James A Fossos has ignored the laws of the State of Washington and is in flagrant violation of RCW 42.17.080.

As a currently elected public official, Fire Commissioner James A Fossos is fully aware of the laws concerning campaign disclosure and should be held accountable to the fullest extent possible for these intentional and flagrant violations.



Jim,

I have now had a chance to review the complaints filed by Jerry Galland concerning your campaign last Fall. I have also looked at your C-3 (contributions) & C-4 (summary & expenditures) reports. To start, I have two homework items for you to complete.

First, we need to figure out your expenditure reporting. I have attached the last two C-4 reports that you filed and between the two reports there is a \$10,390.24 discrepancy between Line 17 of the 7-day Pre-General C-4 report ("7dPG" filed on 10/31/11) and Line 10 of the Post General C-4 report ("PostGen" filed on 11/7/11).

Since these are consecutive reports the total from Line 17 must 'carry forward' to Line 10 of the next report. However, on your C-4 reports, Line 17 on 7dPG is \$2,618.00 and Line 10 on PostGen is \$13,008.24 – so we need to figure out why these two numbers don't match.

It is possible that several expenditures that were made within the 7dPG reporting period (October 18-31) were entered in Orca <u>after</u> the 7dPG report was filed. So when the next report was filed (the PostGen), the 'carry forward' amount was more than what was reported on the previous report (7dPG).

Please check your expenditures in Orca for this time period and compare with the filed 7dPG report (attached). You can contact one of our Filer Assistants (Chip or Jennifer) and they can walk you through troubleshooting this issue. Also, please let me know what you find.

The next item is the Anonymous Contributions you reported on your C-3 reports (see attached).

The C-3 filed on September 12 reports \$366 for Anonymous contributions.

The C-3 filed on September 27 reports \$226 for Anonymous contributions.

Based on these reports, your campaign received a total of \$592 in Anonymous contributions. State law allows for a total of \$300 in Anonymous contributions.

Please review your records and try to figure out who made these contributions. At the very least, you will need to identify \$292 worth of the contributions. If you are not able to determine who gave these contributions, state law requires that you forfeit anything over \$300 to the State Treasurer. Please let me know what you find out, also, if there is another reason why these are anonymous, please let me know. You will likely need to amend your C-3 reports, which either of the Filer Assistants (Jennifer & Chip) can help you with.

Let me know what you figure out for these two issues. We can also talk about a response letter and any further documentation that is needed at that time. Feel free to contact me with any questions.
