Reason(s) for Modification (as stated by filer)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Mr. Lisbin is requesting a reporting modification that would exempt him from disclosing the business customers that paid \$12,000 or more during the previous 12 months to Point It!, Inc., a privately held online advertising agency located in the Seattle area. • Mr. Lisbin stated that Point It!, Inc. has 50 clients, 40 employees and an annual revenue of \$6,000,000. • Mr. Lisbin is chairman and 98.9% owner of Point It!, Inc. • Mr. Lisbin stated that is not actively involved in the day to day operations of Point It!, Inc. and does not have direct contact with its clients. • Mr. Lisbin stated that almost all of the clients of Point It!, Inc. would be reportable. • Mr. Lisbin believes that disclosing these customers causes a competitive disadvantage for Point It!, Inc. by allowing other Seattle area competitors to have access to the customer list.
Other Issues	<p>Mr. Lisbin stated that Point It!, Inc. does no business with the City of Seattle and that there are no governmental customers.</p> <p>Mr. Lisbin stated that if elected to the Seattle City Council, he will make no decisions that will benefit the customers of Point It!, Inc.</p>
