Explanation of Rule(s)	<p>Applicants whose spouse or registered domestic partner creates a reporting obligation for the applicant: WAC 390-28-100(1)(e)(iv)</p> <p>When an applicant is required to report the activities of an entity solely because the applicant's spouse or registered domestic partner held an office, directorship, general partnership or ownership interest in the entity and the applicant does not have direct knowledge of the information that must be reported, the applicant may be allowed to satisfy the disclosure requirements of RCW 42.17A.710 (1)(g)(ii) and WAC 390-24-020 by disclosing reportable customers from whom compensation in excess of the disclosure threshold established under RCW 42.17A.710 (1)(g)(ii) has been received as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (A) All payments made by the agency or jurisdiction in which the applicant seeks or holds office to the entity; (B) The business and other governmental customers or clients of the applicant's spouse/domestic partner and of the entity of which the applicant is aware; and (C) Any other business and other governmental customers or clients of the entity whose identities are known to the applicant and whose interests are significantly affected by the agency or jurisdiction in which the applicant seeks or holds office. The commission may apply (e)(i) through (iii) of this subsection when the applicant's spouse/domestic partner is a lawyer, judge, or motor vehicle dealer.

Reason(s) for Modification (as stated by filer)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Ms. Olsen is requesting a retroactive reporting modification that would exempt her from disclosing the business and governmental customers for her spouse's law firm, Olsen & McFadden, Inc. PS.• Ms. Olsen states that the law firm is comprised of two attorneys, with \$468,000 gross income in calendar year 2019.• Ms. Olsen states that she does not have any business interest in the law firm and does not have access to the law firm's client list.• Ms. Olsen states that due to attorney client privilege and confidential information she does not have a right to know, or demand to know, who the clients of the law firm are, but has disclosed the purpose of all payments and the actual dollar amount the law firm received from the Kitsap County Superior Court.• Ms. Olsen states that the law firm has been disclosed on every F-1 report filed for the last 14 years and is requesting that the Commission grant this retroactive reporting modification for the last 5 years within the statute of limitations: 2019, 2018, 2017, 2016, and 2015
