Reason(s) for Modification (as stated by filer)	 Mr. Sandstrom is requesting a reporting modification that would exempt him from disclosing the business customers that paid \$12,000 or more during the previous calendar year, to Westsound Workforce, Inc. Mr. Sandstrom's spouse, Julie Q. Tappero, is %100 owner of Westsound Workforce, Inc., a temporary staffing business located in Gig Harbor. Mr. Sandstrom stated that he has no ownership interest in the company and is not involved in the day to day operations.

	Mr. Sandstrom stated that Westsound Workforce, Inc. has 11 internal employees, approximately 400 temporary employees and annual sales of \$3.5 million.
	Mr. Sandstrom stated that Westsound Workforce, Inc. has approximately 120 customers, 45 business customers would be reportable.
	 Mr. Sandstrom stated that Westsound Workforce, Inc. operates in a very competitive industry and that publishing the reportable business customers would put the business at a competitive disadvantage.
Other Issues	Mr. Sandstrom confirmed that Kitsap County has done no business with Westsound Workforce, Inc. In addition, he disclosed the reportable governmental customers during calendar year 2017.
