WAC 390-12-200 Public disclosure commission—Role of the executive director.

The executive director acts as the commission's chief administrative officer and is accountable to the commission for agency administration. In addition, the executive director will:

* * *

(7) The executive director may delegate authority to subordinates, consistent with agency delegation of authority protocols as adopted by the commission, to act for <u>the executive director</u> him or her as needed and appropriate.

(8) The executive director may perform other duties as authorized by RCW 42.17A, WAC 390 or as prescribed or delegated by the commission.
