Reason(s) for Modification (as stated by filer)	 Mr. White is requesting a reporting modification that would exempt him from disclosing the business customers that paid \$10,000 or more during the previous 12 months, when he was appointed, as well as calendar years 2010 to 2013, to Western Polymer Corporation.
	 Mr. White's spouse, Lynn Townsend-White serves as CEO of Western Polymer Corp. with an ownership interest of over 50%.
	 Mr. White stated that he has no ownership interest in the company and is not involved in the day to day operations.
	 Mr. White stated that Western Polymer Corp. is a company that sells potato starch to the paper industry and is located in Moses Lake.
	 Mr. White stated that Western Polymer Corp. has 70 employees and has annual sales of approximately \$10 million.
	 Mr. White stated that the exact number of Western Polymer Corp. customers are unknown to him but he believes about 12 would meet the reporting threshold. He also stated that there are no reportable governmental customers.
	 Mr. White stated that Western Polymer Corp. is a privately held company and that a list of its customers is not publically available.
	 Mr. White stated that the potato starch industry is highly competitive and publishing the reportable business customers would put Western Polymer Corp. at a serious competitive disadvantage.
	 Mr. White believes that the majority of reportable business customers are located outside of the state of Washington.

Other Issues	Mr. White disclosed that if any matter came before him involving Western Polymer Corp., or its customers, that he would recuse himself.
