Reason(s) for Modification (as stated by filer)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Susan Wilkins is requesting a reporting modification that would exempt her from disclosing all of her spouse's reportable financial information on her Personal Financial Affairs Statement she filed as a candidate covering the previous twelve months. • Ms. Wilkins stated that she does not have access to her husband's financial information or their joint investments and that he handles all of their finances including investments, assets, income and tax documents. • Ms. Wilkins stated that her husband will not disclose to her all the details of the financial assets he invests in and that if she was required to produce all financial information she would have to withdraw from the election. • Ms. Wilkins stated that she has no reason to believe any of her husband's managed investments are education related or that her elected position as a school board director would result in any personal financial benefit.
Other Issues	Susan Wilkins reported her husband's name, her and her spouse's occupation with income information, two parcels of real estate entirely owned, and general information regarding an IRA and U.S. Savings Bonds.

<p>Ms. Wilkins has agreed to recuse herself if a matter came before her involving a conflict of interest between her personal interests and the duties, if elected, as a School Director with the Lake Washington School District.</p>
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
