Thanks for asking for input. It might take legislative action to allow the following policy, but here's my suggestion...

It's the bigger donors that significantly impact elections as individuals. Reports that identify the contact information for small donors expose those folks to harassment without providing significant funding information to the public. I would suggest that local organizations be required to keep personal information, so that they can track contributions on a cumulative basis, but that they aggregate contributions of \$50 or less in a C4 reporting period under a single "total miscellaneous small donations" amount, and report personal information only when a donor exceeds \$50 in the reporting period.
