According to our records, you were an elected or appointed official in 2009, and you were required to file an F-1 report disclosing your financial affairs for calendar year 2009. A warning letter was sent to you on May 14, 2010, informing you that we had not received your annual F-1 report, which was due to be filed no later than April 15, 2010. The warning letter notified you that a hearing could be scheduled if the missing F-1 report was not received in our office by May 28, 2010. However, as of May 28, 2010, we still had not received your completed F-1 report for 2009. Therefore, in accordance with RCW 42.17.370 and RCW 42.17.395, a Brief Enforcement Hearing has been scheduled to determine if you have violated RCW 42.17.240 by failing to timely file the F-1 report for 2009.

- A completed F-1 form (blank copy enclosed);
- A signed Statement of Understanding (blank copy enclosed); and
- A check or money order for \$100, made payable to the "Washington State Treasurer."

Faxed or e-mailed reports are not accepted.
