Report of Investigation

**I. Background and Allegations**

- 1.1 During 2009, an unexpected vacancy occurred for Port Commissioner Position 2 of the Port of Everett. To fill the vacancy, a special Declaration of Candidacy filing period was held August 19, 2009 through August 21, 2009. Candidates filing for this position appeared only on the General election ballot. No Primary election was held for this position due to the timing of the vacancy and special filing period.
- 1.2 On September 5, 2009, Tom Stiger filed a Candidate Registration (C-1report) with the Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) for his candidacy for Port Commissioner, Position 2 for the Port of Everett for the 2009 special General election. Five candidates appeared on the General election ballot for this position, including Mr. Stiger. Mark Wolken was elected Port Commissioner on November 3, 2009.
- 1.3 Of the five candidates, Mr. Stiger and Mr. Wolken both selected the full reporting option on the C-1 reports indicating that they would file frequent, detailed campaign finance reports. Sean Edwards and David Mascarenas, two of the 2009 Port Commissioner candidates both selected the mini reporting option on the C-1 reports. Fred Taucher filed a C-1 report on January 23, 2010, after the 2009 general election had been held without selecting a reporting option.
- 1.4 Mr. Stiger was also a candidate for Port Commissioner for the Port of Everett in 2011, was successfully elected, and is currently an incumbent Port Commissioner through 2017.
- 1.5 On October 3, 2011, James Krider filed a complaint alleging that the 2009 Tom Stiger campaign for Port Commissioner violated RCW 42.17.080 and 42.17.090 by failing to file any Campaign Summary Receipts and Expenditures Reports (PDC Form C-4) during the 2009 election cycle. See **Exhibit #1**.
- 1.6 Candidates under the full reporting option and appearing on the November 3, 2009 general election ballot were required to file C-4 reports as follows:

- 21-day pre-general C-4 report: Due on October 13, 2009, covering the period of September 5 through October 12, 2009;
- 7-day pre-general C-4 report: Due on October 27, 2009, covering the period October 13 through October 26, 2009;
- Post general election C-4 report: Due on December 10, 2009, covering the period October 27 through November 30, 2009; and
- Post-election monthly C-4 reports: Due to be filed by the 10th of the month, if the campaign raised or spent more than \$200 since the last C-4 report was filed.

## II. Findings

### Alleged Failure to timely file C-4 reports for the 2009 election (RCW 42.17.080 & .090):

- 2.1 The 2009 Tom Stiger campaign failed to file any C-4 reports during the 2009 election cycle. As a result, the public was not aware of any campaign expenditures for political advertising and consulting, including vendors used, orders placed, or in-kind contribution activities that had been undertaken by the campaign prior to the November 3, 2009 general election.
- 2.2 After being notified of the complaint, Mr. Stiger paper-filed one C-4 report on October 28, 2011, covering the period September 16, 2009 and November 1, 2009. **See Exhibit #2.**
- 2.3 In light of the amount of campaign expenditures reported, PDC staff instructed Mr. Stiger to re-file the campaign's C-3 and C-4 reports electronically using the ORCA filing software in accordance with RCW 42.17.3691 (requiring electronic filing when a campaign spends or expects to spend more than \$10,000). The paper filed C-4 report submitted by the campaign on October 28, 2011, disclosed two expenditures were made by the campaign on October 15, 2009, one to The Herald for a newspaper ad costing \$2,887, and the other to the US Postmaster for postage totaling \$3,327. Those two expenditures brought the campaigns expenditure totals to \$10,784, as of October 15, 2009, and required the campaign to being filing its reports electronically.
- 2.4 On December 8, 2011, the Stiger campaign electronically-filed its 21-day pre-general election C-4 report 786 days late, and its 7-day pre-general election C-4 report 772 days late.
- 2.5 On December 19, 2011, the campaign electronically-filed its post-election C-4 report 739 days late and its December 2009 C-4 report 709 days late. The C-4 reports disclosed \$4,700 in in-kind contributions and \$19,000 in monetary expenditures. **See Exhibit #3.**
- 2.6 The electronically filed C-4 reports corrected the paper-filed C-4 report that had been filed on October 28, 2011. The following chart summarizes Mr. Stiger's total contribution and expenditure activity for his 2009 campaign (per the electronically filed C-4 reports):

2.7 Mr. Stiger's 2009 C-4 reports, which reported the details of \$19,000 in monetary expenditures and \$4,700 in in-kind contributions, were reported on paper-filed reports between 709-745 days late. The C-4 reports disclosed that all monetary expenditures, and the in-kind contributions, were spent on various forms of political advertising, including yard signs, brochures, newspaper ads, postage.

Filing of C-3 reports

- 2.8 During the 2009 special General election, candidates under the full reporting option were required to file weekly Monetary Contributions reports (PDC Form C-3) every Monday, if contributions had been received and deposited during the previous seven days.
- 2.9 The 2009 Stiger campaign timely filed seven C-3 reports, manually, on paper, disclosing that his campaign had received a total of \$13,471 in monetary contributions. The contributions included \$10,000 from Mr. Stiger and \$3,471 from other individuals. The contributions were deposited between September 23, 2009 and October 30, 2009.

Alleged Failure to timely file C-3 reports for the 2009 election (RCW 42.17.080 & .090):

- 2.10 On December 8, 2011, when Mr. Stiger filed his 2009 campaign C-4 reports electronically, he also electronically re-filed all of his previously paper-filed C-3 reports and two new C-3 reports. The two new C-3 reports disclosed \$5,125 in previously un-reported contributions. **See Exhibits #4.** These contributions were filed 707 and 773 days late, as follows:
- The first C-3 report was filed 787 days late on December 8, 2011. It disclosed \$125 in contributions from five contributors, each giving \$25. Itemization of the names and addresses was not required. These contributions were deposited on October 7, 2009.

- The second C-3 report was filed 773 days late on December 8, 2011. It disclosed a \$5,000 contribution from Mr. Stiger's personal funds that was deposited on October 20, 2009.

- 2.11 When Mr. Stiger electronically re-filed all of his previously paper-filed C-3 reports, the monetary contribution totals increased by \$404, resulting in previously un-reported monetary contributions of \$404. The majority of the newly reported contributions on the amended C-3 reports were from individuals who gave \$25 or less. The names and addresses for those small contributors were not required to be disclosed.
- 2.12 The 2009 Stiger campaign reported receiving \$19,000 in monetary contributions, which included \$15,000 from Mr. Stiger's personal funds and \$4,000 from other individuals.

Candidate's personal funds contributed in the form of monetary and in-kind contributions

- 2.13 Mr. Stiger contributed \$19,700 to his 2009 campaign. This total was made up of \$15,000 in monetary contributions and \$4,700 in in-kind contributions. All contributions received by the campaign, monetary and in-kind, were used to pay for political advertising. Mr. Stiger's contributions comprised 83 percent of the campaign's contributions, which totaled \$23,700.
- 2.14 The 2009 campaign timely disclosed that Mr. Stiger made two \$5,000 contributions to his campaign. The contributions were reported within five days of receipt by the campaign.
- 2.15 In December 2011, Mr. Stiger's previously unfiled C-4 reports, and new C-3 reports, disclosed that on October 20, 2009, he gave his campaign an additional \$5,000 monetary contribution, and that on December 1, 2009, he paid for political advertising costing \$4,700 that constituted an in-kind contribution to his campaign. See **Exhibit #5**. The \$5,000 monetary contribution was previously described in paragraph 2.8 of this report.
- 2.16 On October 28, 2011, Mr. Stiger provided PDC staff with a response to the complaint. See **Exhibit #6**. He acknowledged his late-filed C-4 report and stated that he believed he had properly filed his C-3 reports during the campaign. He stated that his failure to properly file was an oversight that occurred while dealing with the election loss and payment of campaign expenses.
- 2.17 On April 2, 2012, Mr. Stiger faxed a letter responding to questions from PDC staff. See **Exhibit #7**. Mr. Stiger stated that he chose to run for the Port position because he had previously served as a Port Commissioner for the Port of Everett over 30 years ago, and he continued to have an interest in Port of Everett activities. He stated that his wife and son assisted with his campaign. He stated,

*"None of us had had any prior experience with the PDC reporting requirements. I admit we did little "homework" in preparing to file and relied mainly on the PDC internet site for information and forms. Because of the special election calendar their [sic] was no opportunity to attend any campaign workshops.*

*I admit the failure to file a final C-4 report was my responsibility and with the loss of the election and bills to pay it was an oversight on my part. I felt we had done a good job of reporting all contributions which I felt was the most important disclosure to make."*

- 2.18 On April 2, 2012, during a telephone conversation with PDC staff, Mr. Stiger stated that his 2011 Port Commissioner campaign attended the PDC Compliance and ORCA training, and that his campaign timely filed its 2011 reports. Staff reviewed the C-3 and C-4 reports filed by the 2011 Tom Stiger campaign and found that the campaign substantially complied in reporting contribution and expenditure activities on paper during the 2011 election cycle. Prior to filing the Post General election C-4 report, the campaign re-filed all of the 2011 C-3 and C-4 reports electronically on December 8, 2011 disclosing that the campaign received contributions totaling \$12,400, and made \$10,256 in total expenditures.
- 2.19 Mr. Stiger has no prior violations of PDC campaign finance or reporting requirements, and has received no prior warning letters from the PDC.

#### IV. Scope

- 3.1 Staff reviewed the complaint filed by James Krider received on October 3, 2011.
- 3.2 Staff reviewed and audited C-3 reports filed during 2009 by Mr. Stiger's campaign.
- 3.3 Staff spoke with Mr. Stiger and reviewed his written response.
- 3.4 Staff reviewed the paper filed C-4 report submitted by Mr. Stiger on October 28, 2011.
- 3.5 Staff reviewed Mr. Stiger's electronically filed C-3 and C-4 reports that were filed on December 8 and 19, 2011.
- 3.6 Staff reviewed Mr. Stiger's faxed response to a PDC staff request for additional information received on April 2, 2012.

#### IV. Laws and Rules

- 4.1 **RCW 42.17.080 and 090** require candidates under the full reporting option to file timely, accurate reports of contribution and expenditure activities, including in-kind contributions. C-4 reports must be filed 21 and 7 days before each election. A post-election report must also be filed when the candidates name appears on the ballot. In the months following the election, if the campaign has raised or spent \$200 since the last report. In addition, C-3 reports are due every Monday disclosing contributions received and deposited during the previous seven days.
- 4.2 **RCW 42.17.3691** states, in part: ...

(2) Beginning January 1, 2004, each candidate or political committee that expended ten thousand dollars or more in the preceding year or expects to expend ten thousand dollars or more in the current year shall file all contribution reports and expenditure reports required by this chapter by the electronic alternative provided by the commission under RCW 42.17.369. The commission may make exceptions on a case-by-case basis for candidates whose authorized committees lack the technological ability to file reports using the electronic alternative provided by the commission.

(3) Failure by a candidate or political committee to comply with this section is a violation of this chapter.

4.3 **WAC 390-19-030** stated in part during the 2009 election cycle:...


(1) The "electronic reporting threshold" that requires electronic filing of all contribution and expenditure reports is met when a candidate or political committee has expended \$10,000 or more in the preceding calendar year or expects to expend \$10,000 or more in the current calendar year.


(2) It is presumed that a filer "expects to expend" \$10,000 or more when any one of the following first occurs:

(a) A filer spends at least \$10,000;

(e) A filer's expenditures meet or exceed \$7,500 on or before September 30 of the current calendar year.



### On the Web

A group opposed to risqué behavior at drive-through coffee huts in Snohomish County has started a Web site, [www.takeactionsnoco.info](http://www.takeactionsnoco.info).

What would be the scope of the law could have unintended consequences.

A portion of Cooper's ordinance would do away with a rule that deems businesses adult if they get more than 25 percent of their business from adult entertainment. Cooper wants that to apply to any businesses that make money from porn or nudity.

Gossett said doing away with the 25 percent requirement could have unintended consequences for corner stores that sell adult magazines that only account for a small portion of business.

"We want to deal with this and we want to deal with

this right," Gossett said.

Cooper acknowledged that his proposal needs work, but says that it's time for a serious discussion to begin at one of the council's upcoming Monday or Wednesday meetings. That way, they can start work before the end of the county budget process, which lasts through November.

"The council as a whole deserves some criticism for not trying to move it forward sooner," he said. "We've got some work to do, but we're committed to starting the process and getting it going."

While elected officials hammer out new laws, people who live and work in South Snohomish County have started a Web site — [www.takeactionsnoco.info](http://www.takeactionsnoco.info) — to show their opposition to the stands. The site includes a list of businesses with work trucks spotted visiting the stands.

"We've had a good handful of businesses appalled that their advertising dollars have

been seen in front of these stands," said Rhonda Bremond, who started the Web site. She owns a business near a Grab-n-Go Espresso stand and has been a vocal opponent.

One business forbade its employees from visiting the stands when its name appeared on the list, she said. Another business had its lawyer send her a cease-and-desist letter.

"I'm not trying to pick a fight," she said. "I want to

alert the public and these businesses. At least we know we see them."

The original plan included posting explicit video footage and photos of baristas caught behaving badly. Bremond said she's still mulling over whether she wants to publicize something she's trying to fight.

"I don't want to turn into a peep show," she said.

prejudice firsthand.

"I went through it," Hafner said. He said he was at Bremerton High School when he came out as a gay teen. "I was 16. It was tough a lot of days."

Thompson, a 1983 graduate of Mariner High School, said he didn't come out until he was 24. Even so, and although he dated girls in high school, other kids "called me gay anyway."

"I was in drama and choir. There is so much stereotyping," Thompson said.

Barbara Clark-Elliott isn't gay, but she knows the visceral fear of

hate-based violence.

"I have a gay son," said Clark-Elliott, president of the Seattle chapter of Parents, Families & Friends of Lesbians and Gays, also known as PFLAG.

The Renton woman said that when her son, now 30, came out at age 19, her worries had nothing to do with parental disappointment, or even AIDS. "My first thought was, 'Oh my gosh, he's going to get hurt by someone who hates him,'" she said.

As for those who argue that hate-crime laws give some groups "special rights," Clark-Elliott said,

In the decade since she's known her son is gay, Clark-Elliott has seen progress. She and other PFLAG members were part of this year's Renton River Days parade. "We were overwhelmed with the response of people along the sidelines. There is clapping and thumbs-up," she said.

I have enclosed the C-4 form for the November 3, 2009 Port of Everett Special Election which I failed to file in a timely manner.


I believe the C-3 forms for cash receipts of contributions were properly filed.

This memo/fax is in response to the questions you have asked in your 3/29/12 e-mail.

The special election was necessitated by Commissioner Connie Niva moving out of the port district.

Her move created an opening for the unexpired two year term.. Five candidates filed for the November 3, 2009 election. No one recruited or encouraged me to run for the office, to the contrary, because of my age, 71, some of my family and close friends advised other wise. Having served as a port commissioner over 30 years ago and having a continuing interest in port activities were the motivating reasons for running. Their was no primary election because of the late filing period. I decided to run and filed on 9/4/09.

On the C1 form I listed my wife, Rose Marie Stiger, as treasurer since she worked with me on a daily basis and opened the mail and kept track of the contributions. My son, Chris helped with the campaign and signed the original signature card when we opened a checking account with Frontier Bank on 9/22/09. He made most of the deposits.

None of us had had any prior experience with the PDC reporting requirements. I admit we did little "homework" in preparing to file and relied mainly on the PDC internet site for information and forms. Because of the special election calendar there was no opportunity to attend any campaign workshops.

I admit the failure to file a final C-4 report was my responsibility and with the loss of the election and bills to pay it was an oversight on my part. I felt we had done a good job of reporting all contributions which I felt was the most important disclosure to make. We don't recall any one bringing attention to fact that I failed to report the final C-4 prior to the James Krider complaint being filed.

I hope this reply answers your questions. I will follow up with a phone call to answer any additional questions or to clarify my responses.
