a cash contribution of \$250. plus a loan of \$938.98 totaling \$1188.98 from Ty Haberling to
each candidate. These candidates filed for mini reporting on Candidate Registration forms
C1. The requirement that a single contributor donate no more than \$500. in the aggregate
to a candidate has been violated by each school board candidate.

Dear Mr. Stutzman,

I received your letter dated March 15, 2012 regarding a complaint filed by Mr. Staley Jr. I am writing this letter as directed by you to assist in the investigation and to respond to the allegations. As I understand the complaint, the allegation is that I accepted a \$250 contribution from Ty Haberling, and also had a loan from Mr. Haberling in the amount of \$938.98.

First, I would like to say that this is my first time running for public office in any capacity.

My total expenses for the campaign were under \$5000. All other personal contributions were under the \$500 limit. Mr. Haberling paid the \$938.98 postage cost as a matter of convenience. I repaid Mr. Haberling very quickly, just a few days later. I did not understand that this short term advance also counted as a contribution from Mr. Haberling. My understanding was that as I paid the postage advance back, his contribution of \$250 to my campaign was under the \$500 limit per individual required to complete the short form. I now understand that this was not correct on my part, and I should have paid the postage myself from my contributions.

I accept full responsibility for this mistake and misunderstanding. It was completely unintentional. I am willing to do whatever is needed to make this right.

In summary, this is my first experience with running for public office, and the learning curve has been steep. My total contributions were under \$5000. All other individual contributions were under \$500. The postage paid by Mr. Haberling was paid back very quickly, and it was my understanding (incorrect it turns out) that his contribution of \$250 was under the \$500 limit required for me to file the short form. Please accept my sincere desire to do whatever is necessary to make this right.
