Dear: Mr./Ms. MACOMBER

According to our records, you filed a Declaration of Candidacy to run for public office in 2013. As a candidate, you are required to file a Candidate Registration (C-1 Report) and a Personal Financial Affairs Statement (F-1 report) within two weeks of filing your Declaration of Candidacy, or no later than May 31, 2013. On July 3, 2013, PDC staff sent you a warning letter, with a blank C-1 report and a blank F-1 report, informing you that we had not received your C-1 or F-1 reports.

The warning letter notified you that a hearing would likely be scheduled if the missing C-1 report and F-1 report were not received by July 17, 2013. Therefore, in accordance with RCW 42.17A.110 and RCW 42.17A.755, a Brief Enforcement Hearing has been scheduled. The hearing will determine if you violated RCW 42.17A.205 and 42.17A.700 by failing to file the required C-1 and F-1 reports. Under the Brief Enforcement Hearing rules, the Presiding Officer has the authority to assess a penalty of up to \$500, in accordance with a penalty schedule adopted by the Commission.

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

I will be representing the Commission staff at the hearing. I am enclosing a Brief Enforcement Hearing brochure along with a copy of the C-1/F-1 penalty schedule.

If there are circumstances you wish to have considered at the hearing, you may attend the hearing in person, or participate by telephone. If you cannot participate at the hearing, you may submit a written response that will be provided to the Presiding Officer prior to the hearing. 

We have previously forwarded you a copy of the complaint filed by John Mueller on July 24, 2013. However, I am enclosing an additional copy of the complaint. The complaint alleged that as a 2013 candidate for King County Council, you failed to file any reports of contributions or expenditures, an alleged violation of RCW 42.17A.235 and .240. You selected the Full reporting option on your Candidate Registration (C-1 report) filed July 22, 2013, but have not filed any Cash Receipts Monetary Contributions reports (C-3 reports) or Campaign Summary Receipts & Expenditures reports (C-4 reports). The complaint alleged that you maintained a web site and engaged in other campaign activities without reporting any expenses. The complaint also alleged that you solicited campaign donations, but have not reported receiving any contributions.

PDC staff will investigate Mr. Mueller's allegations and notify you of the results when the investigation is complete. To assist our investigation, please respond to the allegations in writing **by February 6, 2014.**

Dear Ms. Macomber:

This letter is a follow-up to the January 23, 2014, letter from Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) staff concerning the complaint filed by John Mueller against your 2013 candidacy for King County Council. PDC staff has not received a response to the January 23, 2014 letter, or the letter staff previously sent to you concerning Mr. Mueller's complaint filed against you on July 24, 2013.

To reiterate, Mr. Mueller's complaint alleged that as a 2013 candidate for King County Council, you failed to file any reports of contributions or expenditures, alleged violations of RCW 42.17A.235 and .240. As previously stated, our records indicate you selected the Full reporting option on the Candidate Registration (C-1 report) you filed July 22, 2013, but to date we have not received any Cash Receipts Monetary Contributions reports (C-3 reports) or Campaign Summary Receipts & Expenditures reports (C-4 reports).

The complaint alleged that you maintained a web site and engaged in other campaign activities without reporting any expenses, and that you solicited campaign donations, but have not reported receiving any contributions. To assist our investigation, please respond to the allegations in writing **by April 18, 2014.**

At this point a summary of the contributions you received and the expenditures you made on behalf of your candidacy would be helpful to assist with our investigation, along with a written response. That summary of campaign activities can be provided to PDC staff in a spreadsheet, a Word document, or in an email.

To save PDC and Washington State resources, I have also included the final staff notification concerning the \$250 outstanding penalty assessed against you in PDC Case No. 13-136.
