Findings of Fact,
Conclusions of Law, and
Order Imposing Fine

A brief enforcement hearing (brief adjudicative proceeding) was held July 8, 2014, in Room 206, Evergreen Plaza Building, 711 Capitol Way, Olympia, Washington to consider whether the Respondent violated RCW 42.17A.700 by failing to file a Personal Financial Affairs Statement (F-1 report) due April 15, 2014, disclosing financial information for calendar year 2013.

The hearing was held in accordance with Chapters 34.05 and 42.17A RCW and Chapter 390-37 WAC. A brief enforcement hearing notice was sent to Tye Shanholtzer on June 10, 2014. Commission Member Amit Ranade was the Presiding Officer. The Commission staff was represented by Jacob Berkey, Compliance Coordinator. The Respondent submitted a written statement for consideration at the hearing.

Having considered the evidence, the Presiding Officer finds as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. The Respondent was an incumbent School Director for Cusick School District 59 in 2013.
2. As a School Director, the Respondent was required to file an F-1 report no later than April 15, 2014.
3. The Respondent filed the missing F-1 report after the April 15, 2015 deadline and by the date of the hearing.
4. The Respondent has no prior violations.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Based on the above facts, as a matter of law, the Presiding Officer concludes as follows:

1. This matter was duly and properly convened and all jurisdictional, substantive and procedural requirements have been satisfied.
2. The Respondent violated RCW 42.17A.700 by failing to file the F-1 report by April 15, 2014.

ORDER

ON the basis of the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Respondent is assessed a civil penalty of \$100 in accordance with the penalty schedule set forth in WAC 390-37-160. Of the penalty \$50 is suspended on the following conditions:


1. **The \$50 non-suspended portion of the penalty is paid within thirty days of the date of this order; and**
2. **Respondent commits no violations of RCW 42.17A for the next two years from the date of the order.**

If the Respondent fails to comply with any of these conditions, the suspended portion of the penalty will become immediately due and payable without further action by the Commission.

This is an **Initial Order** of the Public Disclosure Commission.
