

File a Formal Complaint - Glen Morgan

To Whom it May Concern --

It has come to my attention that despite the Attorney General lawsuit against the Thurston County Democratic Central Committee (Thurston Superior Court #17-2-00972-34), and despite multiple attempts to encourage compliance with the statute through the PDC complaint process, the Thurston County Democratic Central Committee has continued to violated **RCW 42.17A**.

1) State law requires that the name and address of any person and the amount owed for any debt, obligation, note, unpaid loan, or other liability in the amount of more than two hundred fifty dollars or in the amount of more than fifty dollars that has been outstanding for over thirty days. Per WAC 390-05-295, this includes any oral or written order placed, debt or obligation to purchase goods or services or anything of value, or any offer to purchase advertising space, broadcast time or other advertising related product or service.

a) Failure to report towing debt.

On information and belief, the Thurston County Democratic Party utilized the towing services of Jerry's Towing to get their food trailer into position for Capitol Lakefair, Tenino "Oregon Trail" Days, and the Thurston County Fair. These fairs have all recently occurred. They have utilized this service but they have not yet paid for it, indicating that it needs to be reported as debt.

Last year, the Thurston County Democrats went to all or most of the above-listed events, and paid Jerry's Towing \$633.22 for the associated towing services. This is over the \$250 thresholds specified in the statute.

It is also possible that this was an in-kind contribution from Jerry's Towing, in which case, it would have to be reported as such, and the failure to report this will still be a violation.

b) Failure to list debt associated with venue rental.

The Kennedy Dinner is the largest fundraising event for the Thurston County Democrats -- despite the fact that, according to Jim Cooper in his correspondence to the PDC, it lost money for the Thurston County Democrats last year.

Here is information about the event:

The Kennedy Dinner is our largest event of the year and it is going to be spectacular!

When: Saturday, September 16th

Time: 4:30 pm - 9:30 pm

Location: Indian Summer Golf and Country Club, 5900 Troon Ln SE, Olympia, WA 98501 (off of Yelm Hwy)

On information and belief, the TCDP has failed to list the cost that they are contractually obligated to pay for using this venue. While records indicate a payment of \$6,867.35 to Indian Summer Golf Course, my experience with this venue is that this is likely only the deposit. Note that they provide catering as well as the venue.

c) Failure to report legal debt.

After being sued by the Attorney General's Office, the Thurston County Democrats contracted with Pacific Law Group to defend them in court. On information and belief, the Thurston County Democrats are failing to report this as a debt/obligation. They appear to only be reporting their expenditures when they write the check to the attorney.

The Pacific Law Group is mustering a formidable defense of the Thurston County Democrats' poor campaign finance reporting, and yet the firm has only been paid \$9537.74 according to PDC records. The work that the Pacific Law Group has put into the case likely exceeds this paltry expenditure. Thurston County Democrats will owe Pacific Law Group far more than this amount, and must project this as debt moving forward.

2) Failure to list all committee officers. (Violation of RCW 42.17A.205 (2)(c), see WAC 390-05-245.

The Thurston County Democratic Party failed to timely list Boudicca Walsh as Chair, which is required by **RCW 42.17A.205(2)(c)**.

It should be noted that Boudicca Walsh identifies as a "Trans Radical Witch of Olympia", according to his testimony at a recent Olympia City Council meeting. Boudicca is sure to be a transformative leader for the Thurston County Democrats and she is probably just coming into his own in an effort to take over from the previous failed leadership of Katie Nelson. While I support her as the perfect leader for the Thurston County Democratic Central Committee, there still problems he has to

address with how the party fails to follow the law with their campaign finance reporting.

Per PDC regulation, they had 10 calendar days (until July 5th) from Boudicca's election as chair, to their amending their C1 report. Unfortunately, they failed to do this until 8/7/2017, well past the statutory deadline.

The PDC should investigate the possibility that the Thurston County Democratic Party committed the above violations maliciously. If these violations were committed in an effort to evade public scrutiny and campaign finance disclosure, this would be a class C felony per **RCW 42.17A.750 (2)(c)**. If the PDC determines that is the case, they should refer the case to the Attorney General's office for criminal prosecution immediately.
