Dear Mr. Churchman:

The Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) has completed its initial review of the complaint you filed today. Your complaint alleged that John Hopkins may have violated RCW 42.17A.700 by not reporting Puyallup Fair stock on his Personal Financial Affairs (F1) report.

PDC staff reviewed your allegations to determine whether a formal investigation or enforcement action is warranted. As a result of staff's initial review, we found the following:


- Mr. Hopkins owns one share of stock in the Puyallup Fair with a value below the \$2400 reporting threshold.
- Mr. Hopkins has no previous violations of PDC laws and rules.

Based on these initial findings, I have determined no further action is warranted at this time.

The PDC has closed the matter, and will not be conducting a more formal investigation into your complaint or pursuing enforcement action in this case.
