Hello. Thank you for forwarding the three complaints from Mr. Van Putten.

As Treasurer of the Committee for Judicial Readiness, I appreciate Mr. Van Putten's help improving our compliance, and want to assure him - and you - these errors were not intentional, and certainly not meant to obscure our activities.

Regarding the first two items - late reporting - the complaints are valid. We formed the Committee practically at the end of the reporting period and so overlooked the need to file for only a few days' worth of activity.

Additionally, I inadvertently "froze" of our account when I checked the box for "single election campaign;" this was invalid (since we're participating in the primary and potentially the general elections). At any rate, this mistake it hard to file until your staff was able to work around the technological problem.

Regarding the third item - failure to note Mr. Sheeran - I'm not sure why this is the subject of complaint. I completed the form identifying Mr Sheeran as the "against" candidate. Perhaps you or Mr. Van Putten could help me understand my failure here.
