Fox,

My name is Mark Boswell. I am running for State Representative Pos 2 in the 31st Legislative District.

This contact with you is because of PDC Case Number 38727. There are three items listed in the complaint. I am including the answer to the third item below. I tried to input my F1 electronically, but the system wouldn't take it. So I contacted a responsible person in the department and sent file by email. The email below is the confirmation of receipt.

Later that day, as I was preparing the C1, my wife and I got word that our son was in the emergency ward at Harborview Medical Center in Seattle. He had been severely injured in a five car accident that afternoon on the Aurora Ave Bridge. He was the most injured of all those involved, had been cut out of his car unconscious and transported to Harborview. He has been home with us since then, recovering from his numerous injuries including a severe concussion. To say the least, that has been my priority. His ongoing recovery is slow.

I have two friends helping me with the campaign. The one that volunteered to be the treasurer has never had anything to do with politics before, but is highly capable. He said he thought he could learn ORCA and took the online classes. We found out later, from someone with significant ORCA experience, that the ORCA documentation online is incomplete and out of date. It appears that ORCA also downloads a virus (malware?). Because of my home situation, I wasn't able to be responsive in assisting my treasurer with the problems. Some of the information I had received and gave to him, like my filing number, didn't work.

Once my son was past the point where my wife and I felt one of us always needed to be around to help him I have been able to get the campaign moving forward again. My treasurer has been able to work around some of the ORCA software documentation errors. Apparently though, until we can provide the correct candidate filing number, the system will not take the C1.

The included email should eliminate item 3 of PDC Case Number 38727. I would like to know how best to proceed, and was looking for some help and/or guidance. Please give me a call at 253-709-1290.
