Dear Dennis Olson:

The Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) has completed its initial review of the complaint you filed on 8/7/18. Your complaint alleged that See Attachment may have violated Chapter 42.17A RCW for failure to register and report as a political committee, and failure to report independent expenditures or electioneering communications.

PDC staff reviewed your allegations, and as a result of staff’s initial review, we found the following:

- The complaint submitted regarding Indivisible groups called out Washington Indivisible by name and alleged various violations of Chapter 42.17A RCW, yet supporting exhibits concerned Seattle Indivisible and Indivisible Washington's 8th District.
- No evidence in the record suggests any violations by the Washington Indivisible group as a statewide organization.

Based on these initial findings, staff has determined that in this instance, no evidence supports a finding of an actual material violation warranting further investigation.

The PDC has closed the matter, and will not be conducting a more formal investigation into your complaint or pursuing further enforcement action in this case.
