Dear Mr. Ravens:

The Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) has completed its initial review of the complaint you filed on May 3, 2016. Your complaint alleged that Bill Bryant may have violated RCW 42.17A.700 by failing to include information on a Personal Financial Affairs (F1) report.

PDC staff reviewed your allegations to determine whether a formal investigation or enforcement action is warranted. As a result of staff's initial review, we found the following:

- Mr. Bryant did not include information on his 2015 candidate F1 report for Silver Fir Digital LLC, as alleged in the complaint.
- When notified of the complaint the Bryant campaign amended the report to contain the missing information.
- Bill Bryant does not have any previous violations of RCW 42.17A.

Based on these initial findings, I have determined Bill Bryant's failure to include information for Silver Fir Digital LLC on his first F1 report does not amount to a material violation warranting further action under these circumstances. In accordance with PDC practice, WAC 390-37-060 he will receive sent a warning letter with a reminder to follow PDC laws and rules.
