Dear Ms. Harrell:

The Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) has completed its initial review of the complaint you filed on June 28, 2016. Your complaint alleged that Just Want Privacy (JWP) PAC may have violated RCW 42.17A.235 and .240 by failing to report contributions and expenditures.

PDC staff reviewed your allegations to determine whether a formal investigation or enforcement action is warranted. As a result of staff's initial review, we found the following:

- JWP relies on an online service provider to process online contributions. There were issues with the fraud system that slowed down the deposit process. These contributions were deposited within 5 days of receipt and have been reported.
- JWP's May payroll was paid during the first week of June and is reported on their C4 report on July 11, 2016, within PDC reporting timelines.
- The in-kind contribution from Family Research Council of \$48 is reported on Schedule B of the C4 report filed on July 11, 2016.

Based on these initial findings, I have determined Just Want Privacy PAC has substantially complied with applicable requirements by reporting contributions and expenditures, and no further action is warranted.

The PDC has closed the matter, and will not be conducting a more formal investigation into your complaint or pursuing enforcement action in this case.
