Dear Mr. Erickson:

The Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) has completed its initial review of the complaint you filed earlier today. Your complaint alleged that People for the Fairgrounds (PFF) may have violated RCW 42.17A.235 and .240 by failing to report campaign expenditures in excess of the \$5000 mini reporting threshold.

PDC staff reviewed your allegations to determine whether a formal investigation or enforcement action is warranted. As a result of staff's initial review, we found the following:

- People for the Fairgrounds filed a Committee Registration (C1) report on June 2, 2016, as a single year committee under the Mini Reporting option.
- On June 30, 2016, PFF placed an order for 7500 double sided postcards and postage. The total of that order was \$2226 – under the \$5000 limit for Mini Reporting.
- PFF has no previous violations of PDC laws and rules.


Based on these initial findings, I have determined there is no reason to believe a material violation of any law under the Commission's jurisdiction has occurred. The PDC has closed the matter, and will not be conducting a more formal investigation into your complaint.
