Dear Mr. Burke:

The Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) has completed its initial review of the complaint you filed on September 6, 2016. Your complaint alleged that Jeff Randall, candidate for Jefferson County PUD commissioner, may have violated RCW 42.17A.235, .240, and .320 by failing to include sponsor identification on campaign advertisements and report expenditures.

PDC staff reviewed your allegations and found the following:

- The Randall campaign purchased 300 campaign fliers that did not have required sponsor identification. The campaign has since updated its order to include required sponsor identification.
- The expenditures for the campaign advertising was reported on their September, 2016, C4 report as required by PDC laws and rules.
- Mr. Randall has no previous violations of PDC laws and rules.


Based on these initial findings, I have determined failure to include sponsor identification on 300 fliers does not amount to a material violation warranting further investigation. Pursuant to WAC 390-37-060(1)(b), Mr. Randall will receive a warning letter, and a reminder to include sponsor identification on campaign materials in accordance with PDC laws and rules.
