Dear Ms. Ohlde:

The Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) has completed its initial review of the complaint you filed on October 5, 2016. Your complaint alleged that "No on Prop 1" may have violated RCW 42.17A.205, .235, .240, and .320 by failing to register and report as a political action committee, and by failing to include sponsor identification on political advertising.

PDC staff reviewed your allegations, and as a result of staff's initial review, we found the following:

- Barbara Parsloe created the website masoncountymfocus.com and distributed a flier urging a no vote on Prop 1. The total out of pocket expenses amounted to \$20 which was reported on a C6 Independent Expenditure report on October 5, 2016.
- When made aware of the complaint Ms. Parsloe added sponsor identification to her fliers to come into compliance with RCW 42.17A.320.
- Ms. Parsloe has no previous violations of PDC laws and rules.

Based on these initial findings, I have determined that Barbara Parsloe complied with RCW 42.17A. – and even went beyond her reporting requirement by reporting an independent expenditure of less than \$100.


The PDC has closed the matter, and will not be conducting a more formal investigation into your complaint or pursuing further action in this case.
