The documents details the strict coordination efforts between Superintendent Hill, WSBA No. 31016, Pasco School District No. 1 and Pasco Citizens for Better Schools to influence the outcome of the election.

The email contains Pasco School District No. 1 Levy Committee Meeting Dates, Pasco School District No. 1 Levy Committee Marketing Ideas, Pasco School District No 1 Levy Committee Committee Assignments (including Pasco School District No. 1 staff), Pasco School District No. 1 Public Affairs Calendar, as well as Pasco Citizens for Better Schools List of members and contact information (including Pasco School District No. 1 staff, their public email addresses and and public telephone numbers).

Rather than putting an immediate stop to this use of public resources for the illegal support of a campaign measure with public resources, staff and time, Superintendent Hill, WSBA No. 31016, seeks additional public support and resources.

It is noted that Pasco School District No. 1 staff are assigned specific tasks related to seeking approval of the levy which exactly parallel their regular job assignments for the Pasco School District No. 1 (e.g. marketing staff assigned to campaign marketing activities). Pasco School District No. 1 staff and employees of other public agencies assigned tasks utilizing public resources on behalf of Pasco Citizens for Better Schools are highlighted.

It should be noted that Teri Kessie is closely associated with Superintendent Hill, WSBA No. 31016, and was later appointed Principal of Pasco School District No. 1 Chiawana High School. Jill Tombs is closely associated with Superintendent Hill, WSBA No. 31016, and whose husband, Darrell L. Toombs Jr., was later appointed to the Pasco School District Board of Directors. In addition, as with the 2013 Bond, Pasco Association of Educators are continually involved in impacting the outcome of the elections.

LEVIES ARE FOR LEARNING AND HELP FUND ESSENTIAL PROGRAMS

Every two years Pasco School District runs a regularly scheduled Maintenance and Operations Levy. Maintenance and operations levies pay for day-to-day educational programs and operations. This is not a new tax but would replace the expiring tax approved by voters in 2008. Levies make up the difference between the cost of educating Pasco's students and the funding received from the state and federal governments—approximately 18% of the budget. If voters approve the levy, the state provides additional money each year for Pasco students through levy equalization dollars. Currently this is an additional \$8 million each year from the state. If voters reject the local levy, the state withholds the levy equalization dollars as well.

Levy dollars pay for personnel who work directly with students or keep our schools in top condition. Specifically, they fund the functions below:

53% for Teaching and Learning

Curriculum and instructional materials
Art, music, and drama teachers and programs
Counselors, nurses, and partial cost of home visitors
Librarians, library clerks, and library books
Assistant principals
Teacher benefits and substitute teachers

6% for Activities and Athletics

Academic teams and clubs
Athletics
Activities

41% for Maintenance and Operations

School Security
Maintenance and custodial personnel
Maintenance and custodial supplies
Utilities, insurance, and fuel
Student transportation

THE BUDGET SITUATION

Due to the economic situation in our state, Pasco School District has already addressed a \$14 million budget shortfall this year through significant budget cuts, eliminating or reducing programs, postponing tasks, and reprioritizing functions in order to preserve jobs. The district has been informed to expect additional cuts from the state for the upcoming year, depending upon the upcoming legislative session. However, the challenge lies in the fact that the board must set the levy amount before the legislature even begins to meet.

The Pasco School District Board of Directors is faced with a tough decision. If current assumptions hold true, maintaining the levy at the rate previously approved by voters would likely lead to significant cuts in levy-funded programs. Even raising the rate could mean a potential, through smaller, reduction in programs.
