File a Formal Complaint - Larry L. Mann

My suspected complaint is based on two entities that I believe to be operating illegally.

First, operating in the very visible public eye is South Kitsap School Supporters (SKSS) committee soliciting and receiving donations from businesses, soliciting money (change) from shopper's purchases e.g. money cans placed in businesses all over the school district, and receiving money from citizens e.g. Debbie McComber \$150K for football field playing surface.

I'm unable to find SKSS committee listed with PDC for 2015 or 2016 in order to collect funds for anything dealing with education.

Second, operating hidden from the public SKSS operates under the electronic name "YES4SK" with their very few members listed at <http://www.yes4sk.com/contact> (<http://www.yes4sk.com/contact>) with a very obvious "donate" button-soliciting donations. Additionally, "YES4SK" has a facebook page <https://www.facebook.com/Yes4SK-303426589773646/> (<https://www.facebook.com/Yes4SK-303426589773646/>) also having a very obvious "donate" button-soliciting donations.

I'm unable to find "YES4SK" listed with PDC for 2015 or 2016 in order to collect funds for anything dealing with education.

Last, on 9 January 2016 first contact of any information on the up-coming school bond was made with a threefold flier in the mail (attached). By very close observation, nowhere on any page is there a statement about who financed or supported the printing of this flier. I attempted to attach scans of this flier but kept getting kick off of the complaint form.

I contend to the PDC that SKSS and YES4SK organizations have been given hundreds of thousands of dollars by the Washington Education Association (WEA) and the South Kitsap Education Association (SKEA) excluding any/all other unknown/unreported funds to these groups for the passing of the bond in question on 9 February 2016.

NOTE: I would respectfully request to know and be notified about the result of this complaint e.g. committee's shut down, fines imposed, media notification of PDC action, etc. I believe the voters need to know PDC action on this information hopefully before ballots come out or at minimum before they vote on 9 Feb.
