Dear Micaiah - Thank you for giving me the opportunity to respond to the latest complaint filed by Glen Morgan I served as Treasurer for the Zita for Port campaign in 2017.

You will find that the majority of Mr. Morgan's complaints are lacking in any evidence and are simply untrue. Mr. Morgan has willfully and habitually filed unsubstantiated and frivolous complaints in an effort to discourage participation in the democratic process by everyday citizens. His efforts have caused many experienced campaign volunteers to decline to volunteer on campaigns as the ONLY way to avoid being subjugated to his antics. I, having no experience in political campaigns, chose to serve this election season largely because I don't like bullies. If there are amendments that need to be made to the campaign reports, I will happily make them. Accusations of willful lawlessness, while keeping with Mr. Morgan's love of hyperbole, are inaccurate and offensive.

In my consultations with the staff at the PDC they have been not only professional, but consistent. They have always advised to file reports with the information available and amend them if necessary. This is what I have done. Just this week I have received additional documents from campaign volunteers and as I review these documents I will make any necessary amendments to the PDC reports.

1. Failure to file accurate, timely C3 and C4 reports.

Based on my review of the ORCA system, all reports have been filed.

Reports that are missing information (addresses) will be amended as that information is obtained.

Mr. Morgan is claiming that amended reports are a violation. This is in direct conflict with the repeated advice given to me by PDC staff.

2. Failure to accurately, timely report debt.

The loan to Bob Jacobs was recorded by written instrument as required.

The other transactions listed are not loans.

3. Failure to properly break down, describe expenses.

I will amend reports to include numbers of items purchased and sub-vendors if necessary.

4. Failure to list committee officers.

Officers were listed on C-1 as required.

5. Illegal unauthorized expenditure of funds by an individual not listed as an officer on form C-1/C1-pc.

This, like the majority of Mr. Morgan's unsubstantiated allegations, is pure fantasy.

6. Failure to include the addresses of donors

I will continue to make every effort to obtain the missing donor addresses and will amend reports when that information is obtained.

7. State law establishes contribution limits for candidates.

There are no contribution limits for this race. Mr. Morgan appears to have copied and pasted his usual complaints into this one, without reviewing the facts.

8. State law requires that the committee treasurer preserve books of account, bills, receipts, and all other financial records of the campaign or political committee for not less than five calendar years following the year during which the transaction occurred.

I have all the records that I am aware of.

9. Failure to record loan by written instrument, failure to identify lender's occupation, name, city, and state of employer.

This loan was recorded by written instrument.

It was immediately determined that the campaign did not need the loan and the funds were returned.

10. Failure to include sponsor ID.

All Facebook advertisements were paid for by the campaign.

There were no sponsors to identify.

11. Illegal depositing of campaign funds into bank account by person other than the treasurer or deputy treasurer.

Campaign funds were deposited into bank account by the Treasurer and Deputy Treasurers.
