

PDC Statement of Understanding
Saundra Hill, Pasco School District Superintendent

PDC Case No. 2331 (Formerly Case No. 13-097)

Saundra Hill, Pasco School District Superintendent, acknowledges that by Notice of Administrative Charge (December 4, 2015, incorporating a Report of Investigation of same date), the PDC staff concluded that (a) one question in a 2011 multi-question survey, and (b) one question in a 2012 multi-question survey (collectively, the "surveys") were in part for the partial purpose of promoting a ballot proposition in violations of RCW 42.17.130 and RCW 42.17A.555. The surveys were issued by the Pasco School District during the administration of Superintendent Hill.

In order to avoid the time and expense resulting from a Brief Adjudicative Proceeding (brief enforcement hearing) before the Commission, I have voluntarily and knowingly entered this Statement of Understanding pursuant to WAC 390-37-142, and enclosed a check or money order in the amount of \$100.

I understand that this will resolve all issues concerning the violations alleged in the Notice of Administrative Charges in PDC Case No. 13-097 and 2331, provided that a check or money order for \$100 and this signed Statement of Understanding are received by PDC staff prior to the scheduled brief enforcement hearing.

I further understand that the Commission will not hold a brief enforcement hearing regarding the alleged violations of RCW 42.17.130 and RCW 42.17A.555 as described above.
