Public Disclosure Commission Statement of Understanding

Working Families of King County PAC: PDC Case 37103

Working Families of King County PAC, ORZURWELLS, hereby acknowledge that Working Families of King
(Printed Name of Committee & Officer/Respondent)
County PAC:

Failed to timely file Summary Campaign Contribution and Expenditure reports (C-4 reports) disclosing contribution and expenditure activities undertaken during the 2016 and 2017 elections, in violation of RCW 42.17A.235 as follows:

1. 2016 Pre-General Election C-4 reports: Working Families of King County PAC (WFKC PAC) filed a C-4 report on November 10, 2016, covering the period October 1 through October 31, 2016. The C-4 report was filed by WFKC PAC two days after the November 8, 2016 general election had been held, disclosing \$10,470 in monetary contributions received, and \$10,108 in expenditures made that included three monetary contributions made to Truth for Washington PAC, an affiliated political committee. Truth for Washington PAC used those funds for independent expenditure television advertisements of more than \$1,000 within 21 days of an election that supported or opposed 2016 legislative candidates in the 11th, 33rd and 47th Legislative Districts.

WFKC PAC failed to timely file a 21-Day Pre-General Election C-4 report that was required to have been filed on October 18, 2016, and a 7-Day Pre-Primary Election C-4 report that was required to have been filed on November 1, 2016, in violation of RCW 42.17A.235.

2. 2017 7-Day Pre-General Election C-4 report: WFKC PAC filed a C-4 report on November 22, 2017, covering the period October 1 through 31, 2017. The C-4 report was filed by WFKC PAC 15 days after the November 7, 2017 general election had been held, disclosing \$4,274 in contributions received, and \$4,235 in expenditures made that included a \$4,000 contribution made to Truth for Washington PAC.

WFKC PAC failed to timely file a 21-Day Pre-General Election C-4 report that was required to have been filed on October 17, 2017, and a 7-Day Pre-Primary Election C-4 report that was required to have been filed on October 31, 2017, in violation of RCW 42.17A.235.

WFKC PAC would like to avoid the time and expense resulting from a Brief Adjudicative Proceeding (Brief Enforcement Hearing) being scheduled by Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) staff.


Therefore, in lieu of PDC staff scheduling a Brief Enforcement Hearing, WFKC PAC is completing this Statement of Understanding, and enclosing a check or money order in the amount of \$300 as a penalty payment in this matter.

The \$300 penalty being assessed includes \$150 for each of the acknowledged violations of RCW 42.17A.235 by WFKC PAC for failing to timely file C-4 reports disclosing contribution and expenditures activities involving the 2016, and 2017 elections. The \$300 penalty being assessed is in accordance with the Penalty Schedule adopted by the Commission for Brief Enforcement Hearings set forth in WAC 390-37-143.

I understand that by completing this Statement of Understanding, WFKC PAC is acknowledging the violations of RCW 42.17A set forth above, and waiving its right to a hearing in this matter.
