Reason(s) for Modification (as stated by filer)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Judge Buckley is requesting a reporting modification that would exempt him from reporting real estate, including street address, parcel number, or legal description, on his Personal Financial Affairs Statements for 2013. • Judge Buckley stated that as a Thurston County District Court Judge, he is responsible for a staff of 27, a budget in excess of \$3 million and the court facility involving both criminal and civil cases in Thurston County. Judge Buckley also serves as the county's Mental Health Court and Veterans Court judge. • Judge Buckley stated that in September 2012, he was assaulted at his residence by someone who appeared at his home and threw sulfuric acid in his face when Judge Buckley answered the door. There have been no arrests made to date. Investigators believe that the assailant obtained Judge Buckley's address through an internet search. • Judge Buckley stated that, in an unrelated incident, a defendant in a criminal case he presided over served papers meant for him on his wife at their front door after apparently obtaining his residential address through access to public records.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Judge Buckley has sold his former residence, purchased a new residence and taken necessary precautions to remove the address of property he owns with the appropriate auditors' offices.
Other Issues	Judge Buckley disclosed the creditor information, payment terms, security given, and the mortgage and assessed values for the property he owns.
Staff Recommendations	Approve renewal of reporting modification with no change.
